SC Chamber Applauds Senate Approval Of Bill To Shorten Legislative Session

COLUMBIA, S.C. – State Chamber of Commerce President Ted Pitts released the following statement applauding Senate approval of S.267, a bill that would shorten the legislative session. The South Carolina Chamber has listed S.267 as a Key Vote on its 2016 Legislative Scorecard. The bill will now go to the House for its approval:

“South Carolina has one of the longest legislative sessions in the country which has served as a deterrent to many qualified business men and women who would otherwise be interested in joining our citizen legislature. The business community has long supported a shorter legislative session to improve efficiency and to allow individuals from more professions to serve.
