

City Housing Authority Is Thanked by Army

Appreciation to Columbia Housing authority for co-operation with defense housing in the City of Columbia was expressed yesterday by Maj. Ellis Moore, Fort Jackson billeting officer.

Major Moore said the action of the Housing authority in turning 100 units of its Gonzales Gardens housing project over to the army for housing enlisted men and their families had been of much help in solving the problem of finding places for the families of these men.

"However, the need for such units is great just now," he added. "There is in the billeting office a waiting list of more than 100 for any possible vacancy in the Gonzales apartments. Scores of other enlisted men would gladly take such units if they were available. The price range of these units is such that the enlisted men can afford them."
