

Reports SECTION 3: The Commission unanimously passed a motion accepting monthly reports as published by the Department for the month of May, 1988.

Prchs SECTION 4: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving purchase orders issued for amounts in excess of \$1,000.00 during the month of May 1988, as shown in the Appendix.

Agrmt Greiner Eng & LPA Group SECTION 5: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into an agreement with Greiner Engineering Sciences, Inc. and the LPA group to provide engineering services for the design of the Isle of Palms Connector in Mount Pleasant at an estimated cost of \$1,000,000 funded by Federal Aid Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation funds, as shown in the Appendix.

Sup Agrmt SECTION 6: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into a supplemental agreement with Sverdrup Corporation to perform the 1988 inspection of the Grace Memorial Bridge in Charleston County at an estimated cost of \$300,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

Agrmt DeLeuw Cather & LPA Group SECTION 7: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into an agreement with the joint venture of DeLeuw, Cather and Company and the LPA Group to provide professional engineering services for the proposed Myrtle Beach Connector at an estimated cost not to exceed \$1,792,520.91, as shown in the Appendix.

Agrmt Kimley Horn & Assoc SECTION 8: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into an agreement with Kimley Horn and Associates for design services of the Hilton Head Cross Island Expressway at an estimated cost of \$3,550,000 funded from SHIMS funds, as shown in the Appendix.

W & Assoc SECTION 9: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into an agreement with Ralph Whitehead and Associates for design services for the proposed replacement of the Dawhoo River Bridge on Route 174 near Edisto Island at an estimated cost of \$525,000 funded by Federal Aid Bridge Replacement and Rehabilitation funds, as shown in the Appendix.

Agrmt M. B. Jr. Inc SECTION 10: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into an agreement with Michael Baker, Jr., Inc. to provide engineering services for the design of the Battery Creek Bridge replacement on S. C. Route 802 at an estimated cost of \$185,000 funded from State Primary/Urban funds, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 11: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in entering into a contract with Campco Engineering, Inc. for engineering services for the Anderson bypass feasibility study in the amount of \$179,305 funded from State Primary/Urban funds, as shown in the Appendix.




