Commissioner's Column

Looking for unique gifts? Don't look far

Steve Dowdney and his son Tom are spending a lot more time in the kitchen lately. They're increasing the hours of operation at Rockland Plantation Olde Fashioned Products to 20 hours, just to keep up with demand for the Christmas season. Their ultra-popular products—old-fashioned grits, Carolina Pluff Mud, Dilly Beans, Peach Leather and other specialty foods—make such wonderful gifts that Christmas shoppers just can't resist.

So Steve and Tom are stepping up production. Their old-fashioned grits, one of their most popular items, are as popular outside South Carolina as they are to folks in Mt. Pleasant, where Rockland Plantation is located. The grits are regularly served at the 21 Club in New York City and the Ritz Carlton in Atlanta. The grits are made with S.C. corn—the same corn that was grown in antebellum South Carolina. And their packaging—10-ounce, brown duck canvas—is one of the product's greatest attractions. Steve says many folks buy the grits only to display them in their kitchens.

Rockland Plantation is busy year-round, but even more so now. That's because it won't be long before our streets and homes are lined with garland and lights. And that's when many of us will realize we're not even close to completing our holiday shopping. As a testament to the high quality and uniqueness of our specialty products, just look to Martha Stewart, a famous homemaker. In this month's issue of *Martha Stewart Living*, Rockland's pickled okra, part of their Hoppin' John's line, is highlighted. And just recently, Carolina Plantation's rice was named the best-tasting choice in Stewart's U.S.-Grown Rice Flavor Contest. Carolina Plantation in Darlington County is the only place in South Carolina where rice is commercially grown.

Many of our specialty products are sold in grocery stores and specialty grocery stores. Still others are sold at individual shops and roadside markets. At any of our Certified Roadside Markets, you can find all kinds of preserves, jams and relishes. But that's not all. For example, at the Rustic Market in Sumter, owner Caroline Sigmon sells jars of Soup Starters—jars of vegetable soup that only need to be warmed. Some warm the soups straight from the jar, while others add beef or other vegetables to their liking.

A wonderful S.C. hor d'oeuvres combination for holiday parties is Blazer's Shrimp Dip, made in Greenwood, and Dare crackers, processed in Spartanburg, both of which can be found in specialty grocery stores.

Gourmet pecans are also popular holiday gifts and treats and can be found at Preference Plantation and Golden Kernel Pecan, just to name a few.

In our next issue, we will list our Specialty Food producers to help you with your holiday shopping. Even if the businesses aren't close to you, most will ship the gifts you choose. Firms rush to market their products internationally

As a part of the S.C. Department of Agriculture's continuous efforts to globally promote our state's products, we will again make our presence known at next year's U.S. Food Export Showcase.

The global marketplace isn't just for automobiles, electronics and textiles, it's also for agricultural goods—if they are well-marketed. The annual Export Showcase is one of the most important venues we have for showing those goods to international buyers. At the Showcase, there are unlimited opportunities for agribusinesses in South Carolina. The businesses lease spaces at the Showcase to display their products, which are seen by buyers from 130 countries. Exposure to these buyers not only results in on-site sales and contracts for agribusinesses, but future sales and contracts. The showcase is held at McCormick Place in Chicago—a space three times as large as Williams-Brice Stadium here in Columbia.

"This showcase is incredible," said SCDA's International Marketing Specialist Roy Copelan. "Exhibitors are selling everything from fruits and vegetables to snacks and candies—and they're selling them to thousands of international buyers. The opportunities for S.C. businesses are unlimited."

The entire production wouldn't be possible without the National Association for State Departments of Agriculture (NASDA)—which sponsors the Showcase—the Foreign Agricultural Service of the USDA and the Food Marketing Institute. From these organizations, states or businesses can rent spaces at McCormick Place at a subsidized rate. The SCDA rents three spaces for the event, and offers those spaces to three S.C. firms that wish to take advantage of the opportunity.

"Firms jump at the chance to participate," Copelan said.

Indeed, two firms have already secured two of SCDA's three 12-foot-by-12-foot spaces at the show, leaving a spot for only one more. International Industries of Spartanburg and Meggett's Harrell Farms will occupy the two booths.

Forest fertilization workshop scheduled

Private, non-industrial forest landowners and commercial foresters can increase the wood volume of their loblolly pine forests by fertilization, Clemson experts say.

To inform interested individuals and businesses about forest fertilization, Clemson University's Extension Service in Greenwood will host a workshop on the subject Tuesday, Nov. 30, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the Master Gardeners' Store in Crosscreek Mall.

The workshop will be hands-on and held outdoors. It's designed to provide a general introduction to forest tree fertilization. The field tour will visit potential sites for fertilization. Some have been fertilized, some thinned and fertilized, and others have been herbicided and fertilized. In addition, participants will learn techniques to evaluate an area's potential response to fertilization.

University of Georgia's Dr. David Dickens will be the instructor. He has extensive research experience in fertilizing pines with inorganic fertilizers, sewage sludge and animal waste.

Forest fertilization has been increasing in recent decades—more than 1 million acres of pine plantations were fertilized in 1998. But, until recently, fertilization information was primarily held in the industry, according to County Extension Agent Wallace B. Wood. Now, that information is filtering down to landowners.

Registration is \$50 per person, and the deadline is Nov. 15. Landowners may receive a discount. The workshop is limited to 50 participants, so if you're interested, call Philip Epps today at (803) 276-1091.

Farm and City: Preserving farms for the future

"Preserving Farms for the Future" is the topic of the South Carolina Agricultural Council meeting on Thursday, November 18, at the SC Farm Bureau Office, 724 Knox Abbott Drive in Columbia. The meeting begins with registration at 9:30 a.m. followed by the program at 10 a.m.

The November Ag Council meeting is a few days prior to Farm-City Week, the week of Thanksgiving—a prime time to mend fences and build bridges between rural and urban people. The common goal of farmer and non-farmer is the same—to preserve the land. The question to be answered in the November Ag Council meeting is: "Just how do we preserve the land and, at the same time, meet the needs of everyone involved—farmer and non-farmer?" Today, urban and industrial development is putting concrete where there was once farm land. Guest speakers, knowledgeable about farm land preservation, include: Ken Driggers of the Palmetto Conservation Foundation; John Walpole a farmer concerned about agricultural land preservation; and Senator Phil Leventis, Chairman of the Senate Agriculture and Natural Resources Committee.

Dot's Sweet Potato Pecan Cheesecake

Ingredients: 1, 6-oz. pkg. zwieback crackers, crushed; 5 eggs; 1/4 cup sugar; 6 tablespoons melted butter; 3, 8-oz. pkgs. softened cream cheese; 3/4 cups sugar; 3/4 cups packed light brown sugar; 2 cups cooked, mashed sweet potatoes; 1 teaspoon cinnamon; 1/2 teaspoon nutmeg; 1/4 teaspoon ginger; 1/3 cup heavy whipping cream; pecan topping*; whipped cream, pecans

Directions: Blend zwieback crumbs, 1/4 cups sugar and butter in medium bowl. Press firmly over bottom and up sides of a lightly greased 9-in. spring form pan. Chill. Beat cream cheese in a large bowl with electric mixer at medium speed until smooth. Add sugars gradually, beating until well-mixed. Beat in eggs, one at a time, until light and fluffy. Beat in sweet potatoes, cinnamon, nutmeg and ginger. Add heavy cream at slow speed. Pour into chilled crust. Bake at 325° for 1 hour and 35 min., remove cake from over and sprinle with pecan topping. Bake an additional 10 minutes. Cool cake on wire rack. Refrigerate several hours. Garnish with whipped cream and pecans.

*Pecan topping: Combine 6 tablespoons softened butter with 1 cup packed light brown sugar in a small bowl; mix until crumbly. Blend in 1 cup coarsely chopped pecans.
