Blast from the Past --The Civilian Conservation Corps (CCC) built a beautiful boardwalk along the beachfront at Myrtle Beach State Park in the 1930's. Notice the fishing pier in the background- our first pier at the state park was built in front of the CCC cabins on the northern section of the park in 1950. Also note the lack of development in the city of Myrtle Beach. Hurricane Hazel in 1954 would change this landscape forever- both the boardwalk and the pier were destroyed. The boardwalk was gone forever, but the park rebuilt the pier in the same location.
