The North American river otter has many adaptations that make it an excellent hunter. Their eyes are designed for accurate under water vision. This leaves them near sighted while on land. They also have a highly developed sense of smell that they use to help locate their prey. Even their whiskers around their mouth and nose (called vibrissae) help in the hunt by enabling them to detect turbulence in the water from their quarry.
