Description/Significant Features:

The Pastorium is a single-story, frame structure. Central doorway located beneath a projecting front-gabled porch structure, supported by heavy brick posts. West of the door are two single six-over-six, vinyl windows; east is a tripartite window with a central picture window flanked by single six-over-six, vinyl windows and a single six-over-six, vinyl window. The western elevation has a side entry door and two single six-over-six, vinyl windows; the eastern elevation has two single six-over-six, vinyl windows. Gabled addition extends south from the rear elevation and a two-bay, vinyl-sided garage has been appended to the rear addition.
