

To Gov. Haley office

With the new drug law, I'm charged with trafficking, but it does not apply to me. It only applied to distribution and possession. I had less than 15 grams and traveled less than 15 miles, but you have someone who is selling in possession of 21 to 28 grams, and the law applies to them. The yard that I'm on you have many inmates with possession and distribution charges which are 85% nonviolent are returning home to their family. I rejoice in their blessing to see an inmate go home. I committed a drug charge no different than the ones that committed distribution and possession. The drug law should apply to all drug cases. I'm not trying to justify me committing a crime. I stood before the judge, and except my punishment. I have 4 boys and a daughter, and this is what I teach them when you are wrong take your punishment. I have worked from 2012 to 3/17/16, I have completed jumpstart, and I have a jumpstart certificate, and I am taking the class again as a table leader. I never had any write ups. I do what I need to do. My case worker said I have 435 good time and work credit. I was sentence to 5 years 85% if you do the math 85% of 5 years will be 4 years 3 months. My wife is school teacher for 31 years. I sold realstate for 20 years. My math says I am over doing my time. I don't know if I have a legal ground to stand on, but I'm looking into it. Gov. I have so much respect for you, and what you have done for the people of S.C. You have done alot for the prisoners. Will you have someone from your office look into this? Respond to this.
