

W. R. Simpson named Southeastern Farmer of the Year

A Manning farmer has been named the Lancaster/Sunbelt Expo Southeastern Farmer of the Year for South Carolina.

W.R. Simpson was chosen as the South Carolina winner over four other candidates. He was nominated by Clemson Extension agent Russell Duncan and is one of eight winners from the Southeastern states. He will go on to compete for the 2001 Southeastern Farmer of the Year award.

The other seven winners are from Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Mississippi, North Carolina, Tennessee and Virginia.

"I am very excited that Mr. Simpson won this award," said Duncan. "He has survived natural disasters and difficult economic times to build a well-run farming operation."

Simpson was chosen as the state winner in judging conducted by the Clemson University Extension Service on July 1.

Simpson's land, which covers 1,900 acres, has been in his family since 1905. He and his son Bill farm over 1,000 acres of corn, 700 acres of wheat and 850 acres of soybeans.

Simpson began farming in 1968 as a hobby. He became a full-time farmer in 1969 while also working an outside job.

As the South Carolina winner, Simpson will receive a \$1,500 cash award from Swisher International, an expense paid trip to the Sunbelt Agricultural Exposition in October in Moultrie, Ga. and a \$500 gift certificate from Southern States Cooperative.

Pumpkin Festival

Parking for the festival will be located at the intersection of Highway 8 and Highway 135. Campers will not be allowed to park or camp in the parking areas adjacent to the festival grounds. An area will be available at the intersection of Highway 8 and Highway 135.

Any producer within the district wherein nominated who produced soybeans during the past year is entitled to participate in the meeting.

District 2 includes the Counties of Aiken, Allendale, Bamberg, Barnwell, Calhoun, Edgefield, Hampton, Lexington, Orangeburg, and Richland.

District 3 includes the Counties of Clarendon, Darlington, Florence, Lee, Marlboro, and Sumter.

District 4 includes the Counties of Dillon, Georgetown, Horry, Marion, and Williamsburg.

District 5 includes the Counties of Beaufort, Berkeley, Charleston, Colleton, Dorchester, and Jasper.

Under said Marketing Order, oral nominations, seconded by not less than (5) qualified producers, for qualified candidates shall be accepted by the Commission. Nominations may also be made within five (5) days after each said district meeting by written petition filed with the Commission and signed by not less than five (5) affected producers entitled to participate in such meeting. The term of office of the members elected and/or appointed to fill said vacancies shall be (3) years.

Commissioner's Column

A "MAiZE"ing Agritainment

Recently I had the pleasure of visiting a wonderful new attraction in the state of South Carolina. Nestled in a cornfield in Enoree, located in northern Laurens County, is an a"maize"ing adventure for citizens of our state, both young and old.

Stewart Farms has joined over 100 other farms in the United States and Canada in this new form of agricultural entertainment. The MAiZE, founded by Brett Herbst in Utah in 1996, started with a farm and a field of corn. From there, it has grown into a company that is bringing extra income to farms all over North America. The mission is simple---to provide an enjoyable and educational source of good farming fun to communities around the country.

Farmers apply to The MAiZE and once accepted they begin construction of a vast maze in the their cornfield. Each maze has a different theme and comes complete with "passports" or clues to help groups find their way through the field. The main goal of The MAiZE is to teach, to provide education about agriculture to those that flock to the farms as part of an Ag in the Classroom program.

The MAiZE at Stewart Farms combines a Gamecock, a Tiger paw, and the words Gamecocks and Tigers within the paths. Stretched over 6 acres of corn, the maze provides a challenge that can take anywhere from 15 minutes to two hours, depending on the pathways chosen. Open from Labor Day until October 30, the MAiZE offers school groups, church groups and families the chance to "get lost" in its network of twists and turns.

Opening weekend for the Stewart Farms maze proved to be a good one even though the weather tried to put a damper on things. Angie Broome of Stewart Farms said that they had a very good turnout and that at least a third of their customers came from Columbia where they had heard of the MAiZE from local newspapers. Angie says that she is having a good time with this project and that it has been a learning experience.

The groups that showed up Labor Day weekend enjoyed the maze thoroughly, with one group completing it in a record time of 32 minutes. Another group took around 2 1/2 hours and only ended up winding their way through half of the maze. Corn Cops have been put in to place in various parts of the maze to help those that are directionally challenged and also to "police" the maze-goers.

Stewart Farms welcomes all ages to come and visit the newest trend in outdoor entertainment. They are open Monday and Tuesday by appointment only, Wednesday and Thursday from 4 until 8pm, Friday from 4 until 10pm, Saturday 10am to 10pm, and Sunday 2 to 8pm. Starting in October, the MAiZE will also have a haunted twist. The Field of Screams haunting starts just after dark and is sponsored by local church and youth groups. Garden Plants/Plant and Flower Advertisers!

Certification (Section 46-9-10) and registration requirements (Section 46-33-90) of the SC Code of Laws were established to monitor nursery products for harmful insects and diseases and to prevent noxious weeds from invading the state.

The law defines nursery stock as "all fruit, nut, and shade trees, all ornamental plants and trees, bush fruits, buds, grafts, scions, vines, roots, bulbs, seedlings, slips, or other portions of plants (excluding true seeds) grown or kept for propagation, sale, or distribution."

You are in violation of this law, if you are a dealer or reseller, nurseryman, or hobbyist and you grow and/or sell nursery stock in SC and are not certified by Clemson University's Department of Plant Industry.

Also, you are in violation of the law, if you are a nurseryman or hobbyist and you do not register. And, you are in violation of the law, if you sell \$5,000 or more in nursery stock per year (unless otherwise exempt by the law) and do not register and pay the registration fee established in the law. There is no registration fee if you sell less than \$5,000 in nursery stock per year, but you still must register.

To assist in this endeavor, we have changed the rules and regulations of our Plants & Flowers and Garden Plants categories to include the following:

- In order to sell nursery stock (including plants, flowers, and garden plants) through the *Market Bulletin*, you must be registered with Clemson University's Department of Plant Industry. Advertisers must now submit their registration number with their ads for the Plants and Flowers category and for the Garden Plants category.

- Anyone who sells \$5,000 or more in nursery stock per year may not advertise in the Plants & Flowers and Garden Plants sections of the *Market Bulletin*. Commercial operations are not allowed to advertise in this publication.

- Only one ad per family is allowed per category per issue to allow other SC families the opportunity to advertise, if they wish. Advertisements in the same category under different names of family members and friends will be rejected.

You should be aware that from time to time, the *Market Bulletin* is monitored to confirm that advertisers are certified or registered according to this law.

Help protect SC's special places. Comply with the law. Keep noxious weed, insect, and disease infestations out of SC to protect our state's agricultural and natural resources.

Call your Clemson University Extension Service County Office listed in the phone directory or the Department of Plant Industry (864 646-2130) to find out how to register your nursery stock.
