John Caldwell emailed me a list today of DMV's Legislative Requests for this upcoming session. I called back later to see if that included DMV's package for the Title 56 Cleanup. He stated it did not.

Previously John told me he had forwarded DMV's list to David to see what would be approved before he did the textual changes. At the meetings on the Title 56 Cleanup it had been decided that all Divisions would forward their packages to me and I would forward one big package to HQ for their approval prior to it going the Governor's Office and then to the General Assembly. I have checked with John several times since our last meeting and he always indicated he had not got any final word from David on what changes DMV would be submitting.

This morning when I talked with John, he indicated it was his understanding that after our meetings you had worked with Marsha on DMV's Title 56 Cleanup and that he thought you may have already met with the Governor's Office on it. It this correct? If so, when did it go to HQ for approval and can our office get a copy of the package since our Office is in charge of tracking legislation for DPS?

Additionally, I have items in the Title 56 Cleanup that were suggested by STP, HP and HQ that need to be included in whatever packages gets submitted. I have been holding off sending these to HQ because I was waiting on the items from DMV since they would be the bulk of the package. I know this needs to be sent ASAP.
