Holly, I talked with Barbara Wessinger, an attorney in our office who is very familiar with this issue. She says the regional emergency declaration suspends all of those sections 390-399, not just 395 (hours of service). It is our understanding that once the SC Governor declares a State of Emergency Captain Price at State Transport Police considers sections 390-399 of 49 CFR suspended. Linda
