AFFIDAVIT OF MICHAEL C. GREENE
2007-GS-12-529, 531, 532

PERSONALLY APPEARED BEFORE ME Michael C. Greene who, being duly sworn,
stated:

I am a special agent with the South Carolina State Law Enforcement Division. I was assigned to investigate a letter complaint to SLED made by Delores Fedrick that Chief Mike Revels of the Great Falls Police Department stole money from Ms. Fedrick. Based upon my investigation, I obtained an arrest warrant on May 27, 2009, charging John Michael Revels with Misconduct in Office. The charge is being prosecuted by the Office of the Attorney General for the State of South Carolina.

Several weeks ago Solicitor Doug Barfield contacted me to inquire about the date the alleged offense was committed by Revels. I reviewed the entire file of my investigation of this matter. The arrest warrant alleges the offense occurred on March 31, 2007. That date is in error. I determined the correct offense date is March 31, 2008. Ms. Fedrick's letter to SLED is dated April 20, 2008. In her letter, Ms. Fedrick stated, "On March 31, 2008, at 11:45 AM, I discovered while attempting to get money from my wallet for lunch, that approximately \$400.00 had been stolen from my wallet." Ms. Fedrick further indicated in her letter that Revels recovered a portion of her stolen money from the persons who took it and returned money to her on April 1, 2008. Ms. Fedrick's complaint is that Revels recovered \$210.00 of her stolen money but

returned only \$110.00 to her, keeping \$100.00 of the recovered money. I mistakenly recorded the offense date when I obtained the arrest warrant.

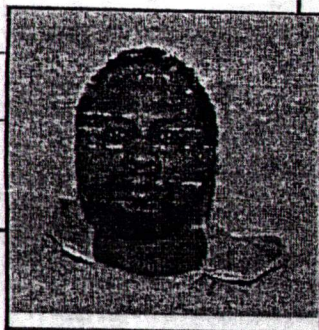
