My name is Nettie Hatchaway and I would appreciate answers to my following questions. I have called many times but so far, no one has addressed my questions. I am going to recap my ongoing inquiries.

My husband, who died May 5th 2010, was a 4yr Viet Nam veteran, his term of service was 21 years with Special Forces. When he passed, I filled out DIC paperwork. It was sent to the commander of Veteran Affairs in Washington DC. In March 2013, I went before the circuit judge in South Carolina to plead my case and so far I have heard nothing. My husband was put on military disability in 1995 and passed in 2010.

I have barely been able to manage living from day to day, but now I need help. I have a heart problem, high blood pressure, and the stress of worrying about how to keep my home has gotten to me.

I have called ~~The~~ Veteran Affairs many, many, many times but no one has helped me in anyway.

As an American wife of an deceased military veteran I am in need of HELP! It is a shame that I have to beg for someone to help me with information that ~~has~~ ^{as} a military spouse I should be able to receive in a timely matter. My finances do not enable me to do what I need to do.

I am on oxygen and I can not afford to use it every day because of the electric bills, along with running the air because the humidity makes it hard for me to breath. I have to alternate my medicine and food because when I need my medicine, I don't buy food or vice versa!

I understand that my medicinal benefits are taken care of and I am grateful but I can't live in the hospital if I lose my house, or go to a soup kitchen? I can't buy food.

Any response would be appreciated and any people or organization that could

contact me would also be helpful.

Please don't forget about me and just discard this letter.

My husband's life was the military and I fondly recall our years with the military
