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I. CURRENT CHARGES

Detainee was arrested and admitted to Kershaw County Detention Center on October 3, 2014. Detainee has the following current pending charges with Kershaw County: Burglary 1st degree, Resisting Arrest, & Malicious Injury. Detainee has the following pending charge with Camden Police Department: Throwing of bodily fluids.

III. CRIMINAL HISTORY

Detainee's current criminal arrest history dates back to 2008. His rap sheet is currently (7) pages long. Detainee's prior history starts in 2008 with a Trespassing charge in Kershaw County SC. Johnson then received a Disturbing schools that same year. In 2009 Johnson was charged with Public Disorderly Conduct, Trespassing, and Burglary 3rd for which he received probation. That probation was later revoked and Johnson was sentenced to 6 months in SCDC. Johnson then was charged with Entry on Another's Land W/O Permission in 2010, as well as a Burglary 2nd, and Petit Larceny that same year. Johnson was convicted of the Burglary and sentenced to 30 months in SCDC. In 2012 Johnson was charged with Public Disorderly Conduct and two counts of Trespassing. In 2013 Johnson was charged with Trespassing. In 2014 Johnson was charged with Assault and Battery 3rd, Resisting Arrest, Burglary 1st Degree,

and Public Disorderly Conduct. In 2015 while incarcerated he received a Throwing Bodily Fluids on an Officer.

THAT ON OR ABOUT NOVEMBER 11, 2015, THE DEFENDANT ROBERT MAURICE JOHNSON DID COMMIT THE ABOVE STATED OFFENSE WHEN HE THREW HUMAN FECES AT CORRECTIONAL OFFICER ROBERT WEINER. VICTIM WEINER THEN ADVISED DEFENDANT JOHNSON THAT HE WOULD BE FORMALLY CHARGED IF HE THREW BODILY FLUIDS AT HIM AND THEN DEFENDANT JOHNSON DID THROW MORE FECES AT OFFICER WEINER. THE HUMAN FECES WAS NOT BELIEVED TO HAVE MADE CONTACT WITH OFFICER WEINER, BUT BOTH TIMES IT DID LAND FAIRLY CLOSE TO WEINER'S PERSON. DESCRIBE INCIDENT: On the above date and time Officer Rabon informed me, Sgt. Ervin Whack that detainee Robert Johnson stated that he was going to hurt himself. On or about 12:15pm, Sgt. Donnie Anthony and Officer Michael Altson reported to A-5 to escort detainee R. Johnson to Intake. Ofc. Alston placed detainee R. Johnson in Holding Cell #4, and then placed detainee Robert Johnson on Suicide Watch. Sgt. Whack, Cpl. James Butler and Ofc. Alston entered the Intake shower area to remove clothing from Detainee Johnson and exchange his uniform into a suicide smock. When Sgt. Whack, Cpl. Butler, and Ofc. Alston exited the shower area with Detainee Johnson he removed the smock and entered into the observation cell. Detainee Johnson refused to wear the suicide smock and began to expose his genital area. Due to Detainee Johnson refusing to wear the suicide smock a paper covering was placed over the lower portion of the windows of Holding Cell 4. Detainee Johnson began to climb on to the sink to continue exposing his genitals. Due to the risk of Detainee Johnson possibly falling and hurting himself Cpl. Butler, Ofc Alston and myself placed detainee Johnson in the restraint chair. A restraint log and a suicide log was placed in effect.



While escorting contractors in A-pod, I noticed that detainee Robert Johnson had damaged the light fixture in cell A5. Officer T. Brooks was in route to the main hallway area, therefore, I asked Officer Brooks to escort the 2 contractors to Classroom #2 as a precautionary measure while I addressed the situation in cell A5; Officer Brooks did so. Officer M. Alston arrived in A-pod and we proceeded to A5 to remove detainee Johnson from the cell. Officer Alston and I both gave verbal directives to detainee Johnson to come out of the cell and detainee Johnson complied without incident. I, Sgt. Anthony, placed detainee Johnson in hand-cuffs behind his back as a precaution and Officer Alston escorted detainee Johnson to the Intake area for follow-up. I then investigated the matter more by checking cell A5 and found that the light fixture had been pulled from the ceiling. No other damage was found in the cell. I radioed to Main Control post Sgt. E. Whack to note in the log book that cell A5 is not to be used until repairs are completed. Cell A5 was tagged as "Do Not Use". I, Sgt. Anthony, then returned to escorting the 2 contractors throughout the facility. More follow-up actions and communication of this incident are forthcoming. End of report as of 8/14/14, 1600 hours.

AT THAT TIME WE RETRIEVED EXTRACTION HELMETS AND THE ENTRY SHIELD. OFC. DURANT THEN ASKED JOHNSON TO PUT THE BOTTLE DOWN AN HE REFUSED. 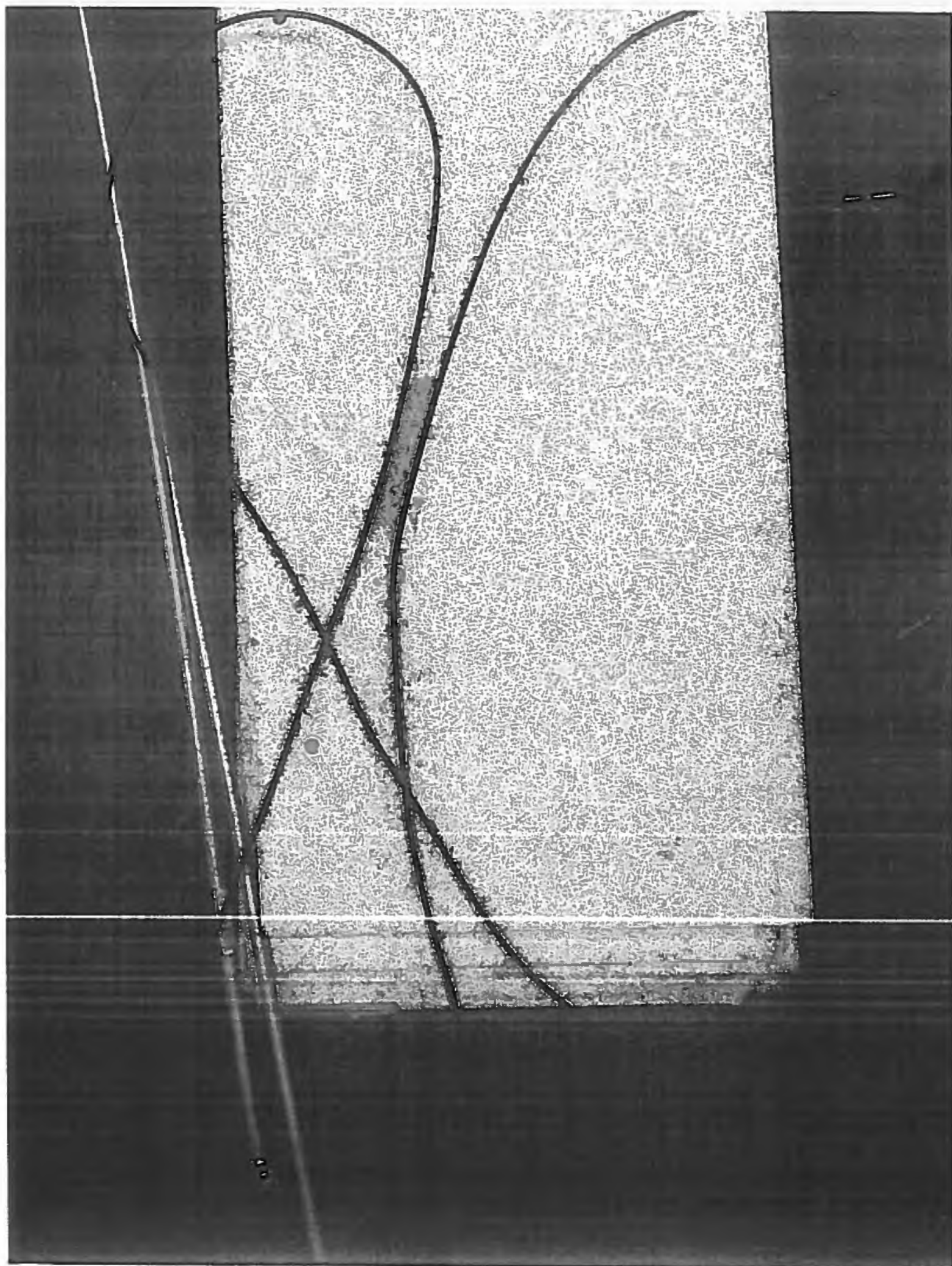

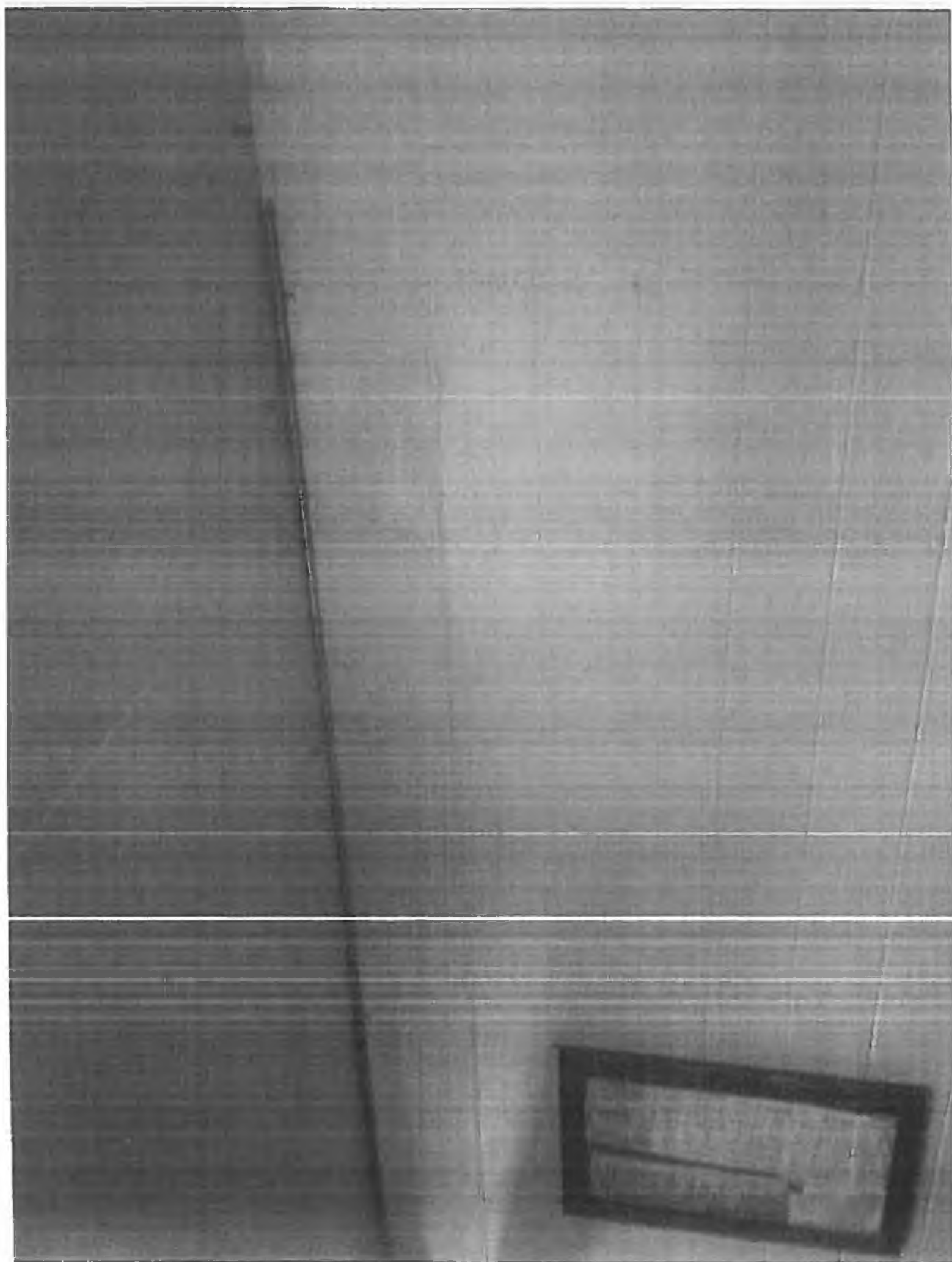



Robert Johnson replied that he was going to throw it. I called for back up to A-pod and Sgt. Whack entered A-pod and escorted the detainees back to A-6, Sgt. Whack gave detainee Morris Nixon a clean uniform and at about 1510 Cpl. Benson entered A-pod and had detainee Robert Johnson come out of cell A-5 to clean the walls and floor in A-pod. End of report



Physician Recommendations:

Vistacil 25mg BID (#60)
