

Important notice to tobacco growers, quota owners

The following is a notice from Karen Estelle Carey of Womble Carlyle Settlement Administration Services, the agency commissioned to administer the state's tobacco settlement.

This notice is to update you on the status of payments from the Phase II Trust Fund. In December 1999, over \$14 million was mailed to growers and quota owners. Another \$5 million will be in the mail by the end of February. While nearly 1,500 growers and 10,000 quota owners have received their 1999 payment, there are many, including you, who have not yet been certified for payment.

Some of the main reasons that forms have not been cleared for payment are:

- failure to sign the forms or include a social security number;
- failure of quota owners to have their ownership documented by FSA;
- failure of heirs of quota owners to update records of deceased owners with FSA;
- disputes or disagreements on the share of ownership by quota owners or growers.

Chase Manhattan Bank, the trustee of the Phase II Trust Fund, will make a third and final round of payments in April, 2000. In order to assist you and the other growers and quota owners who have not yet been paid to complete your certification process, the South Carolina Tobacco Community Development Board and Womble Carlyle have arranged for field consultants to be in FSA county offices from now through March 10.

The location and schedule of the field consultants is shown **page 5**. Please come to the FSA office for your county or the closest county on the days shown on the schedule. The field consultants will personally assist you in completing or making the necessary corrections to your certification form.

If you have returned a certification form and indicated that you were not to receive a 1999 payment, please disregard this notice.

We appreciate your cooperation and look forward to working with you in the coming weeks.

Horsemen's Expo to feature Parelli

Anyone who attends the S.C. Horsemen's Council Annual Meeting and Expo 2000 is in for a treat, because Pat Parelli, world-famous clinician of natural horse savvy methods, will be the keynote speaker at the meeting. In the afternoon, he will also hold a "Savvy Seminar" and demonstration to show others how to connect with horses.

Parelli, known worldwide for his natural horse savvy, which he calls Natural Horse•Man•Ship, has given thousands of courses, clinics and demonstrations around the world in the past 18 years, showing people how the natural approach to horses can be amazingly effective. Parelli has developed an easy-to-follow teaching system to show others how to use his method, which he'll demonstrate to the audience at the expo.

Gates will open for the annual meeting at 8 a.m. at the State Fairground in Columbia on March 18. The morning session is free and open to both Horsemen's Council members and nonmembers. Parelli will open the meeting with the keynote speech at 9 a.m. Ken Smith of Hopkins, the only South Carolinian to ever be president of the American Quarter Horse Association—the largest breed association in the world—will follow Parelli. The SCHC meeting will then take place, and the council will elect officers and give out awards and two scholarships. Throughout the day, there will be a huge trade show at the fairgrounds and concessions.

At 1p.m., Parelli will begin his "Savvy Seminar." Parelli says people need savvy to be good with horses, and that savvy helps people solve problems, banish frustrations and become more creative in their approach to teaching horses. He and his wife Linda will give step-by-step instructions on how to connect with your horse and make the training process seem simple. You must purchase a ticket to attend the seminar, which will be held from 1-7 p.m. Tickets are \$35 for adults and \$15 for children under 18. VIP tickets, which will include reserved seating plus a private reception with Parelli from 4-5 p.m., are \$75. There are discounts for groups of 5 or more. Commissioner's Column

Learning about ag abroad

The landscape of agriculture across the United States and nearby countries is anything but homogenous. It's not even homogenous within the state. As we all know, there are crops and commodities that can grow in a variety of climates and soils and those that can grow only in very specific climates and types of soil. Because agriculture varies wherever we go, there's a lot we can learn from our neighbors.

That, in part, is what the S.C. Department of Agriculture's study tours are all about. Learning. Since the late 1970s, the Department of Agriculture has led many tours to many regions of the United States and nearby countries. Just this month, I returned from our latest Ag Study Tour, which was to the U.S. island of Puerto Rico. It was my first trip to the island, and having worked closely with Puerto Rico's Agriculture Secretary, Dr. Miguel Muñoz, I was eager to see the island I'd heard about so often. More importantly, I was eager to learn what agricultural products the island needs to have imported that can be grown here. Dr. Muñoz is providing me with a list of S.C. commodities that are needed there. My interest has always been in marketing and trade, and I am always looking for new markets for S.C. products.

So I joined about 20 others on the eight-day trip to Puerto Rico. Roy Copelan, SCDA's international marketing specialist, scheduled the group for many tours throughout the island. As with all our Ag Study Tours, the trips include visits to crop and livestock operations, processing plants, horticulture operations and even a few tourist attractions. We studied Pango Mango, a large mango operation on the island. Most of the farmers and agribusiness men and women on the tour had never seen bananas, mangos, or other exotic fruits growing in the field. We also toured a coffee operation called Yauco Selecto. You can find Puerto Rican coffee beans growing on the sides of mountains there, and about 40 percent of the coffee sold on the island is processed at Yauco Selecto.

Naturally, horticulture on the island is very different than it is here. We visited Meyer Nurseries in Aibonito, P.R., and saw an amazing variety of artistic ornamental horticulture. All of these sights would be interesting to farmers and non-farmers alike. But although Puerto Rico is very different agriculturally than South Carolina, there were many things we could learn about and practice here. For example, the tomato operation in Santa Isabel that we visited provided many interesting tips for tomato harvesting and processing, and we saw a Puerto Rican hog and cattle feeding operation. Patricia Frick, who joined us on the tour, even learned a few tips for operating greenhouses that she was able to apply to her own small greenhouse.

Patricia and her husband William, who have been on several Ag Study Tours, agree that the trips are fun and educational. "They are very interesting and we learn a lot," William said. "There is a lot of information you can bring back home." William and Patricia also accompanied the SCDA to Nebraska and Kansas this past August and learned a lot that they applied to their cattle and hay farm in Blythewood.

The SCDA holds two Ag Study Tours each year. The winter tours are held in the southernmost United States or a nearby country, and the summer tours are held in various states. The 2000 Summer Ag Study Tour will be in Oregon and Washington states, from Aug. 9-18. There are literally dozens of tours planned, but here are a few highlights: Oregon Hazelnut Candy Factory, Oregon Coast Aquarium, a cheese factory in Tallamook, Oreg., Mulnomah Falls, livestock ranches, a western alfalfa farm, a sugar beets operation and a potato processing plant in Chelan County, Washington, and much, much more. The tours are never limited to row crops or livestock operations; they also include horticulture, floriculture, aquaculture and processing plants. About 65 percent of the tour is ag-related, while the remaining portion of the trips include sightseeing and cultural tours—all of which are fun and relaxed.

The early bird cost of this trip is \$2,055 per person and \$4,020 per couple, and \$2,280 per person and \$4,450 per couple for those who sign up after May 1. The trip is tax-deductible, and open to everyone. You needn't be a farmer to want to learn more about agriculture.
