

BUDGET AND CONTROL BOARD

RESOLUTION*
ON
HIGHER EDUCATION

WHEREAS, the Budget and Control Board recognizes the need for ordering priorities for spending in higher education and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes that State public colleges and universities must prepare to meet the high technology needs of our state; and

WHEREAS, the Board wishes to allow sufficient time for the Commission on Higher Education to undertake a complete and comprehensive review of priorities in higher education;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Budget and Control Board recommends that all colleges and universities submit by January 15, 1983, to the Commission on Higher Education, plans to meet the high technology needs of South Carolina by reordering their internal priorities within existing budgets. Provided, however, that it is the intent of the Budget and Control Board, through this resolution, that the Commission on Higher Education should have the flexibility to adjust its initial budget recommendations on targeted reductions and increases (in the amount of \$3.2 million), including changes in allocations to individual colleges and universities.

The Board further recommends that after review and evaluation by the Commission, the Commission shall report its recommendations to the House Ways and Means Committee and to the Budget and Control Board.
