**WHEREAS,** people are bombarded with negative images, stories and influences in their day - to - day lives that can lead to a feeling of sadness or hopelessness; and


**WHEREAS,** this discouragement can affect all aspects of a person's life, from their job or schoolwork, to their personal relationships and decision making; and
