2012 Dixie Ponytails World Series : Little Starr-Iva, S.C. rolls to Traditional Division crown

Consider it a big win for all the little towns.

Coming from towns with a combined population of less than 1,500 people, the South Carolina state champions from Starr-Iva completed a dominating run through the Traditional Division of the 2012 Dixie Ponytails World Series Wednesday with an 11-1 rout of Columbia County, Ga. At Byerly Park.

"These girls have put an awful lot of hard work into this," said Coach Danny Davis after being doused with a cooler of ice water. "We finished runner up in the state last year and the girls were determined to get here and make a good showing. I guarantee you they worked as hard or harder than any team out here."

Starr-Iva was never challenged in the five-day tournament, winning four games by a combined score of 40-2.

Against Georgia in Wednesday's championship game, Starr-Iva broke open a 4-1 game with a seven-run third inning. It was their second win of the tournament over Georgia. The first was a 12-2 victory in a second round game on Sunday.

Asked if he expected his team to dominate opponents the way it did, Davis said no.

"I new we had a talented team, but you never expect something like this," Davis said. "These are some very talented teams we played out here and I tip my hat to them. But that says something about just how good a team we have, doesn't it? I honestly couldn't be prouder of these girls and the effort they put forth."

The team from Dyersburg, Tn. was awarded the James E. "Obie" Evans Sportsmanship Award.
