The regular monthly meeting of the Department of Transportation Commission was held at the headquarters building in Columbia, South Carolina at 1:30 p.m. In compliance with the Freedom of Information Act, the news media was advised in writing of the time, date and place of this meeting.

SECTION 1: Chairman Hooper introduced Mr. Joe Young of Georgetown who took his seat as a member of the Commission.

SECTION 2: The Minutes for the meeting of February 15, 2007; copies of which had been previously mailed to each member of the Commission, were approved.

SECTION 3: On behalf of the members of the House of Representatives, Representative Robert Brown presented a framed resolution honoring former Commissioner Robert W. Harrell, Sr. for his service on the Commission.

SECTION 4: On behalf of the members of the Commission, Chairman Hooper presented a resolution and plaque to former Commissioner Robert W. Harrell, Sr. recognizing his outstanding service to the citizens of South Carolina. A copy of the resolution is shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 5: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving an amendment to the 2007 STIP, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 6: The Commission made public a report on the sale of surplus right of way property by the Department and shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 7: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to advertise and select a consulting firm for the purpose of providing subsurface utility engineering and utility coordination services to assist the Department with the development of the widening of SC 707, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 8: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to advertise and select a consulting firm to assist with prefabricated bridge technologies to minimize construction in the replacement of a bridge over the Lynches River and Florence and Lee counties, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 9: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to advertise and select the "on call" consultants for signal systems and advance traffic management system on a statewide basis, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 10: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department in extending an existing pavement marking contract, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 11: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department related to roads in the State Highway Secondary System, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 12: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the action of the Department concerning projects in the highway lettings of February 13 and February 20, 2007, as shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 13: Commissioner Jones reported for the Invitations and Resolutions Committee and made a motion requesting that the Commission sign and forward to the NESAs group a resolution naming I-73 as the state's top transportation priority. Commissioner Stevenson seconded the motion. The motion passed by a vote of 4 - 1. Commissioner Atkins voted "no". Chairman Hooper did not vote but stated he would not sign the resolution at this time since an engineering ranking of new location projects has not been completed. He indicated that he would sign if the engineering analysis indicated this as the state's top new location project. A copy of the resolution is shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 14: Commissioner Carnell reported for the Legislative Committee. The committee received a report on pending legislation in the House and Senate and also received an update on the Federal Corridors of the Future Program. No motions were presented.

SECTION 15: Chairman Hooper reported for the Finance Committee. During the Finance Committee meeting, members of the accounting staff were presented a Certificate of Achievement for Financial Reporting (CAFR) by a representative of the Government Finance Officers Association. The committee was also given information on the upcoming budget process and a federal funding update. The current financial status of the Department, including possible cost reduction areas, was also discussed. No action was taken and no motions presented.

SECTION 16: Chairman Hooper reported for the Audits Committee. The committee confirmed two charters, the Agency Audit Committee Charter and the Agency Audits Charter. A copy of both charters is shown in detail in the Appendix.

SECTION 17: On motion of Commissioner Young, seconded by Commissioner Jones, the Commission unanimously passed a motion to go in to Executive Session.

EXECUTIVE SESSION

The Commission went into Executive Session at 3:47 p.m. for the purpose of discussing legal matters.

OPEN SESSION

The Commission returned to Open Session at 4:35 p.m. Chairman Hooper reported that no action was taken.

SECTION 18: There being no further business to come before the Commission, the meeting was adjourned at 4:36 p.m.

Surplus Property Public Notice

March 15, 2007

In accordance with the State of South Carolina Statute 57-5-340, by this publication the Department is making public the Surplus Property Real Estate Transactions to the State Highway Commission. The following sheets include a breakdown of surplus property real estate transactions. These transactions may have resulted from negotiations with property owners during right of way acquisition, direct sales, settlement of a condemnation action, and/or corrective actions to previously reported sales.

1. File 10.426A / Route I-26 / Charleston County / Sixth District

During construction of improvements on Route I-26, under File 10.426A in Charleston County, in the City of North Charleston, the Department acquired right of way for Route I-26, by Title to Real Estate from South Carolina Federal Credit Union dated December 23, 2003.

A request was received from the District 6 Resident Construction Engineering Office asking the Department to convey a small piece of property to the adjacent landowner to prevent the Department from paying to relocate an electric distribution transformer, which would be in excess of \$20,000.00. Therefore, a gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 289.0167 square feet of land to South Carolina Federal Credit Union was executed on January 31, 2007.

2. File 46.774 / SC Route 274 Relocated / York County / Fourth District

During construction of improvements on SC Route 274, under Project 911 near Lake Wylie in York County, the Department acquired right of way for SC Route 274 by Deed to Right of Way from Duke Power Company dated January 6, 1938; also, under construction of improvements on SC Route 49, under File No. 46.774, the Department acquired right of way for SC Route 274 Relocated by two Titles to Real Estate from Crescent Resources, Inc. dated October 20, 1993.

Under File No. 46.774, SC Route 274 was relocated, which left an old abandoned roadbed and a surplus parcel between the old SC Route 274 and SC Route 274 Relocated that are not needed for highway purposes. The request was circulated to the engineering sections and it was determined that this parcel was surplus to Department needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 3.51 acres of land and a break in the control of access to Crescent Resources, LLC was executed on January 12, 2007 in consideration of \$595,000.00.

3. File 10.432A / US Route 17 / Charleston County / Sixth District

During construction of improvements on US Route 17, under File No. 10.257A/10.432A in the City of Charleston in Charleston County, the Department acquired right of way for US Route 17, by Title to Real Estate from 76 Fishburne, LLC dated February 12, 2001. Also, during construction of improvements on Route I-26, under File No. 10.517, the Department acquired right of way for Route I-26 by Titles to Real Estate from I. S. Keith Ellsworth, Sr. dated December 14, 1965 and from Ella W. Britton dated December 28, 1965, and by Condemnation of Rev. Benjamin J. Finklea dated November 24, 1965.

Pursuant to the Partnership Agreement between the City of Charleston and SCDOT, it was agreed to convey certain surplus parcels of land to the City of Charleston at the completion of the new Cooper River Bridge Project for community enhancement and mitigation. A request was received from the City of Charleston to convey the parcel known as 303 St. Philip Street to the City of Charleston. Therefore, a gratis Quitclaim Deed for 0.092 of an acre to the City of Charleston was executed on February 7, 2007, comprising this lot.

4. File 10.432A / US Route 17 / Charleston County / Sixth District

During construction of improvements on US Route 17, under File No. 10.257A/10.432A in the City of Charleston in Charleston County, the Department acquired right of way for US Route 17, by Titles to Real Estate from Barbara M. Campbell and Melvin Campbell dated February 16, 2001; from Miriam Y. White, et al dated December 29, 2000; from Sumter Properties Partnership dated March 27, 2001; from Hearthstone Properties, LLC dated January 19, 2001; and from Alfred Comfort and Anna Marie Comfort dated January 30, 2001.

Pursuant to the Partnership Agreement between the City of Charleston and SCDOT, it was agreed to convey certain surplus parcels of land to the City of Charleston at the completion of the new Cooper River Bridge Project for community enhancement and mitigation. A request was received from the City of Charleston to convey the parcels known as 304, 306, and 308 St. Phillip Street, and 68, 72 Fishburne Street to the City of Charleston. Therefore, a gratis Quitclaim Deed for 0.292 of an acre to the City of Charleston was executed on February 7, 2007, comprising these lots.

5. File 10.882 / Road S-20 / Charleston County / Sixth District

During construction of improvements on Road S-20, under File 10.882 in Charleston County, near Johns Island in Charleston County, the Department acquired right of way for McLeod Mill Road Extension, by Title to Real Estate from Thomas M. & Sylvia H. Prosser dated July 31, 1997.

A request was received from the Grantee asking the Department to sell a small piece of surplus property. The request was circulated to the engineering sections to determine if said parcel could be declared surplus. After review it was determined that the parcel was surplus to Department needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.12 of an acre of land to Marlene P. Jett was executed on January 31, 2007 in consideration of \$5,000.00.

6. File 30.749 / SC Route 72 / Laurens County / Second District

During construction of improvements on SC Route 72, File 30.749 in Laurens County, in the Town of Cross Hill, the Department acquired right of way for SC Route 39, by Title of Real Estate from Martin L. Duff dated March 7, 2001.

During negotiations for right of way on SC Route 39, the Department agreed to convey a small piece of surplus property to the adjacent landowner in exchange for new right of way that was needed. Therefore, a gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.24 of an acre of land to OK Enterprises of South Carolina, Inc. was executed on January 31, 2007.

7. File 30.749 / SC Route 72 / Laurens County / Second District

During construction of improvements on SC Route 39, Project NRS 377 in Laurens County, in the Town of Cross Hill, the Department acquired right of way for Route 392, by Deed to Right of Way from J. H. Coleman dated November 15, 1933 and by Deed to Right of Way from B. C. Spearman dated November 1, 1933. Also the Department acquired right of way for SC Route 39 by Deed to Right of Way from J. H. Coleman dated March 22, 1939.

During negotiations for right of way on SC Route 39, the Department agreed to convey a section of old abandoned SC Route 39 to the adjacent landowner in exchange for new right of way that was needed. Therefore, a gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.10 of an acre of land to Earl K. Bentley was executed on January 31, 2007.

8. File 30.749 / SC Route 72 / Laurens County / Second District

During construction of improvements on SC Route 72, File 30.749 in Laurens County, in the Town of Cross Hill, the Department acquired right of way for SC Route 39, by Title of Real Estate from Martin L. Duff dated March 7, 2001. Under Route 39 and 392, Project NRS 377 the Department acquired right of way from J. H. Coleman by Deeds to Right of Way dated March 22, 1939 and November 15, 1933, from J. L. Guthrie by Deeds to Right of Way dated March 25, 1939 and January 6, 1934, and from B. C. Spearman by Deed to Right of Way dated November 1, 1933.

During negotiations for right of way on SC Route 39 and SC Route 72, the Department agreed to convey a piece of surplus property to the adjacent landowner in exchange for new right of way that was needed. Therefore, a gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.6 of an acre of land to Donald J. Ravan and Donna H. Ravan was executed on January 31, 2007.

9. Borrow Pit / Route I-95 / Clarendon County / Seventh District

During construction of improvements on Route I-95, in Clarendon County, near the Town of Summerton, the Department acquired right of way for the purpose of a Borrow Pit by Title to Real Estate from Ruby P. Levi date October 29, 1971.

A request was received from the adjacent property owner asking the Department to sell a small tract of land formerly used as a Borrow Pit. The request was circulated to the engineering sections to determine if said parcel could be declared surplus. After review, it was determined that the parcel was surplus to Department needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 3.495 acres of land to Russell Ballard was executed on February 7, 2007 in consideration of \$8,888.00.

10. File 10.434A / US Route 17 / Charleston County / Sixth District

During construction of improvements on US Route 17, under File 10.434A in Charleston County, near the Town of Mount Pleasant, the Department acquired right of way for US Route 17, by Amended Condemnation Notice of Catherine G. Cummings dated May 9, 2005 and recorded August 29, 2006 in Book N-596 at Page 327 in the RMC Office for Charleston County; also under File 10.342 Part 2 the Department acquired right of way for Road S-56 by Deed to Right of Way from Olive Branch Church dated November 28, 1951.

According to a settlement agreement dated October 20, 2006 between SCDOT and Olive Branch African Methodist Episcopal Church, Inc. the Department agreed to convey to the Grantee two surplus parcels of property in exchange for new right of way needed for the construction of improvements to US Route 17 North in Mount Pleasant. Therefore, a gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.47 total of an acre of land to Olive Branch African Methodist Episcopal Church, Inc. was executed on February 12, 2007.

11. File 29.420 / SC Route 9 Business / Lancaster County / Fourth District

During construction of improvements on SC Route 9 Business under File No. 29.420 in the City of Lancaster, in Lancaster County, the Department acquired right of way for SC Route 9 Business by Condemnation of Robin, Inc. dated March 10, 1971.

A request was received from Meeting Street Holdings, LLC asking SCDOT to sell a parcel of possible surplus property due to a parking lot encroachment. The request was circulated to the engineering sections to determine if said parcel could be declared surplus. After review, it was

determined that the parcel was surplus to SCDOT's needs. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.06 of an acre of land to Meeting Street Holdings, LLC was executed on February 22, 2007 in consideration of \$3,825.00.

12. File 46.968 / SC Route 160 / York County / Fourth District

During construction of improvements on SC Route 160, under File No. 46.968 in the Town of Fort Mill in York County, the Department acquired right of way for SC Route 160, by Titles to Real Estate from Mary White Burroughs dated December 9, 1999, from Helen Mackey dated March 31, 2005, and from Albert White and Robert Earl Watson dated March 26, 1999.

In an effort to reduce the surplus inventory, this surplus parcel was offered for bid sale to the two adjacent landowners. The adjacent landowners responded with an offer of \$6,000.00. After reviewing the appraisal of nearby property and area values, this offer was deemed acceptable. Therefore, a Quitclaim Deed for approximately 0.07 of an acre of land to Rameshbabu Ramasubbu and Alagusivakumari Rameshbabu was executed on February 23, 2007 in consideration of \$6,000.00.

13. File 7.615 / SC Route 170 / Beaufort County / Sixth District

A request was received from DEA Robert Clark, asking the Department to convey a portion of the old right of way of SC Route 170 to Beaufort County for the purpose of the County constructing a public boat ramp. The Department has agreed to convey the parcel with a reverter clause. Therefore, a gratis Quitclaim Deed for approximately 6.4 acres of land to the County of Beaufort was executed on February 26, 2007.

Professional Services Recommendations

(COMMISSION DISTRICT 1)

South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) requests Commission approval to advertise and select a consulting firm for the purpose of providing Subsurface Utility Engineering (SUE) and Utility Coordination services to assist SCDOT with the development of the widening of SC-707 as part of the RIDE 2006 Program. The SC-707 widening project begins just south of Road S-26-926 (Enterprise Rd.) and continues southward for approximately 9.2 miles to US-17 in Georgetown County south of Garden City Beach. The period covered by this contract will be from three to five years.

This project will be funded entirely through a combination of Horry County's local option sales tax program funds and State Transportation Infrastructure Bank (STIB) funds.

This extension/deletion is being requested in order to balance contract funds.

This extension was authorized by the Department prior to formal approval by the Commission since the adjacent work had reached such a stage of completion that the contractors involved could not accept the additional work unless it were authorized without delay.

Removal of Roads From State Highway Secondary System

The Department recommends Commission approval for the removal of certain sections of secondary roads from the State Highway Secondary System. These sections of roads may be removed for one of the following reasons:

1. Abandonment of Relocated Section of Highway
2. Deletions and Removal of Roads from State Secondary System - Roads may be deleted and removed from secondary system by exchanging for equal or less mileage or roads, which have a higher traffic importance. Ownership reverts to local government having jurisdiction (city or county). Approval of deletion or removal by local government is not required.
3. Abandonment of Right-of-way - Right-of-way may be abandoned if it is determined that the right-of-way is not required for right-of-way proposes or if the right-of-way is not needed for Department purposes.
4. Court Order

Correction of Description of State Highways

The Department recommends Commission approval of the correction of the description of sections of State Highway previously added to the State Highway System. The description of roads currently in the State Highway Secondary System may be changed for relocation purposes, to revise the description of the termini to show what was actually constructed by contract, county line changes, or a change in the secondary road number.

Additions to State Highway Secondary System

The Department recommends Commission approval to add sections of road to the State Highway Secondary System for construction and maintenance. The Department may add roads to the State Highway Secondary System by request of the County Transportation Committees contingent on mileage being available under the current mileage cap. Roads may be added to the State Secondary System by the construction of a new roadway, accepting existing county/city roads into our Secondary System by the swap method, or by county line changes. Roads added to the State Highway System must be constructed to Department standards or reviewed for compliance with Department standards.

Rescind Action Adding Roads to State Highway Secondary System

The Department recommends the Commission rescind its previous actions adding roads to the State Highway Secondary System for construction and maintenance. The Department may rescind action on roads, which have not been constructed and formally accepted into the State Highway Secondary System. Roads may be rescinded due to right-of-way being unavailable, problems arising during construction, or funding issues.

Transfer of Road between Secondary and Primary Systems

The Department recommends Commission approval to transfer sections of road from the Secondary System to the Primary System, or vice versa. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 57-5-50 of the Code-of-Laws of South Carolina, 1976, the Commission may transfer any route or section of route from the state highway secondary system to the state highway primary system, or vice versa, when, in its judgment, such transfer is advisable to better serve the traveling public.

Detailed information concerning each of these requests is attached.



AND WHEREAS, the I-73 corridor will greatly enhance the economic development of the Pee Dee region;


AND WHEREAS, the I-73 corridor, as a controlled access Interstate, will promote safety;

South Carolina Department of Transportation Audit Committee Charter

Purpose

The purpose of the Audit Committee is to assist the SCDOT Commission in fulfilling its oversight responsibilities for the financial reporting process, system of internal control over financial reporting, external and internal audit processes, and SCDOT's process for monitoring compliance with laws and regulations, and the code of ethics.

Authority

Pursuant to the unanimous decision of the South Carolina Department of Transportation Commission at its meeting of February 15, 2007, an Audit Committee was established and charged with interacting with internal and external auditors and performing specific financially related assignments as the Committee and Commission deem appropriate, and with providing periodic reports to the Commission. This Charter is hereby adopted to clarify the responsibilities of the Audit Committee and delegate to the Audit Committee the authority necessary to accomplish its mission.

Composition

The Audit Committee is a standing committee composed of not less than two commissioners, appointed by the Chairman of the South Carolina Department of Transportation Commission, to serve for such terms as assigned by the Chairman.

Responsibilities

The Audit Committee shall be responsible for the following:

External Audit Groups

Meet with the independent auditor to review the results of the independent audit, including the auditor's recommendations for improvement and management's responses.

Meet privately with the independent auditor, as deemed necessary by the Audit Committee or the independent auditor.

Meet with any other outside audit group such as the Legislative Audit Council or State Auditors Office as appropriate to review results of audits and reviews and to settle disputes between the auditors and SCDOT Management.

South Carolina Department of Transportation Audit Committee Charter

Agency Audits

Approve the appointment or removal of the Director of Agency Audits.

Review with management and the Director of Agency Audits the charter, plans, activities, staffing, and organizations structure of the Agency Audit function.

Ensure there are no unjustified restrictions or limitations, on Agency Audits access to records and information within the SCDOT.

Review the effectiveness of the Agency Audit function, including compliance with Governmental Audit Standards as issued by the United States Government Accountability Office.

Periodically meet with the Director of Agency Audits to review the results of audits, including management's response.

Meet privately with the Director of Agency Audits, as deemed necessary by the Audit Committee or the Director of Agency Audits.

Reporting

Regularly report the results of Audit Committee meetings to the Commission.

**SOUTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (SCDOT)
AGENCY AUDITS CHARTER**

MISSION

The mission of SCDOT Agency Audits is to promote good management, enhance program effectiveness, and improve accountability within SCDOT.

SCOPE OF WORK

The functions of SCDOT Agency Audits shall include, but not be limited to, the following:

1. Conduct internal audits and reviews of SCDOT operations. The audits and reviews will provide objective appraisals concerning department programs and functions and make recommendations for necessary improvements. These audits and reviews will be designed to ensure:
 - a. Risks are appropriately identified and managed.
 - b. Interaction with the various governance groups occurs as needed.
 - c. Significant financial, managerial, and operating information is accurate, reliable, and timely.
 - d. Employees' actions are in compliance with policies, standards, procedures, and applicable laws and regulations.
 - e. Resources are acquired economically, used efficiently, and adequately protected.
 - f. Programs, plans, and objectives are achieved.
 - g. Quality and continuous improvement are fostered in the SCDOT control process.
 - h. Significant legislative or regulatory issues impacting the SCDOT are recognized and addressed appropriately.

Opportunities for improving management control, efficiency, effectiveness, and the SCDOT's image may be identified during audits and will be reviewed with the appropriate level of management.

2. Perform audits and reviews of contracts, grants, or agreements with third party entities. These audits and reviews will be designed to ensure the terms of the contract, grant, or agreement are met and the associated costs billed are appropriate. We will also determine compliance with applicable SCDOT policies as well as federal and state laws and regulations.
3. Perform investigations of suspected fraudulent or unethical activities.
4. Perform any special reviews as approved by the SCDOT Audit Committee.

**SOUTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (SCDOT)
AGENCY AUDITS CHARTER**

ACCOUNTABILITY

The Director of Audits, in the discharge of his or her duties, will report directly to the Audit Committee and be accountable to the SCDOT Commission.

RESPONSIBILITY

The Director of Agency Audits and staff of the Agency Audits department have responsibility to:

- Develop a flexible annual audit plan using an appropriate risk-based methodology, including any risks or control concerns identified by management, and submit that plan to Audit Committee of the SCDOT Commission for review and approval.
- Implement the annual audit plan, as approved, including any special tasks or projects requested by management and approved by SCDOT Audit Committee.
- Maintain a professional audit staff with sufficient knowledge, skills, experience, and professional certifications to meet the requirements of this Charter.
- Periodically provide information on the status and results of audits and the sufficiency of Agency Audit resources.
- Issue periodic reports to appropriate management summarizing results of audit activities.
- Issue all final internal audit reports to the Audit Committee.
- Provide summaries of audits performed on contract, grants and agreements to the Audit Committee. (pertains to audits performed by SCDOT External Audits).
- Consider the scope of work of other auditors and regulators, as appropriate, for the purpose of providing optimal audit coverage to SCDOT at a reasonable overall cost.
- Maintain confidentiality of information obtained during audits.

**SOUTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (SCDOT)
AGENCY AUDITS CHARTER**

AUTHORITY

The Director of Audits and staff of the Audit department are authorized to:

- Have unrestricted access to all functions, records, property, and personnel.
- Have full and free access to the SCDOT Commission.
- Allocate resources, set frequencies, select subjects, determine scopes of work, and apply the techniques required to accomplish audit objectives.
- Obtain the necessary assistance of personnel in units of the SCDOT where audits are performed, as well as other specialized services from within or outside the organization.

The Director of Agency Audits and staff of the Audit department are not authorized to:

- Perform any operational duties for SCDOT or its affiliates.
- Initiate or approve accounting transactions external to the Agency Audits department.
- Direct the activities of any SCDOT employee not employed by the Agency Audit department, except to the extent such employees have been appropriately assigned to auditing teams or to otherwise assist the auditors.

STANDARDS OF AUDIT PRACTICE

The Agency Audit department will meet or exceed the *Government Auditing Standards* issued by the United States Government Accountability Office.
