As an appropriation transfer the Commission authorized the South Carolina Tax Commission to rearrange its appropriations for the fiscal year 1945-46. The permission to rearrange the appropriations in this Section were deemed advisable in view of the fact that the Alcoholic Liquors Tax and the Gasoline Refund Tax Act were passed after the passage of the General Appropriations Act. In granting this permission the Commission also considered the fact that two new Tax Commissioners had been provided in the Alcoholic Liquors Act, and this, together with the new duties imposed upon the Commission by the passage of the above mentioned Acts, appeared to the Commission to be reasonable grounds for such a request.

Admiral Norman Smith, President of the University of South Carolina, Appeared before the Budget Commission and presented to it in detail plans for the expansion of the University. Admiral Smith urged that the Budget Commission take steps as soon as possible to purchase certain lands in the city of Columbia in connection with the expansion program presented. After a full discussion of the matter with Admiral Smith, the Commission decided that action should be deferred until a further and more exhaustive investigation could be made of the needs of the University and of other of the State's educational institutions who were known to be contemplating expansion programs. It was agreed that these matters would be taken up by the Commission at subsequent meetings.

State Forester Charles H. Flory, Senator Ray Williams, and Representative G. B. Nalley appeared before the Commission and urged that funds be granted for the purchase of certain land adjacent to the Paris Mountain park and the Table Rock Park. It was pointed out by these gentlemen that the location of these lands in relation to the Park property created a dangerous situation in that these tracts had lately been offered for sale and that it was feared that they might be purchased by others who would devote them to a use which would be detrimental to the State's interest. After a full discussion of this matter, the State Forester was directed to purchase these lands and pay for same from the appropriation for State Parks already made, and that the Members of the Budget Commission would support a request for a deficiency appropriation to off-set this expenditure. The Secretary was instructed to advise these gentlemen of its action.

Permission for the State Hospital to use an additional \$60,115.48 from the General Fund under authority of the "Insufficiency Provision" in Section 26 of the 1944-45 Appropriations Act was granted by the Commission.

The Commission then adjourned.



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
