Suggested tweak to your language:

In the current fiscal year, the board of trustees of the John de la Howe School shall exercise its duties and responsibilities, as defined in Chapter 49, Title 59, only upon the approval of the Director of the Department of Juvenile Justice . During this period, the board, superintendent, and Director of the Department of Juvenile Justice must establish a process for assessing the needs of each student by comprehensively accounting for the student's developmental, mental health, and educational needs, along with the needs and capacity of the student's family and the availability of appropriate supportive services. The Department of Mental Health, Department of Social Services, and Continuum of Care for Emotionally Disturbed Children shall provide any needed support in conducting these assessments and producing a plan for each child's continued care. No later than April 1, 2015, the Director of the Department of Juvenile Justice must submit an interim report to the Governor and the Chairmen of the House Ways and Means Committee and the Senate Finance Committee containing the status of these assessments and making initial recommendations regarding the appropriate use and management of the John de la Howe School in the future.
