Plant: The Hartsville Rainbow Operations Plant (also known as the Royster-Clark Plant – part of the agricultural services for the Agrium conglomerate) in Hartsville, Darlington County. Employs about 60 people. Produces up to 78,400 tons of fertilizer per year.

Incident: Plant caught fire and exploded around 7pm on Monday, 2/14/11, and quickly spread to surrounding woods.
