The Governor's Office has been named in a lawsuit, and we are trying to identify any records that may be related to this case stemming from the Sanford Administration through the Haley Administration while OEPP was under the Governor's Office.

Accordingly, please check with the OEPP agencies to see if they have any letters, records, or other documents regarding Johnny Timpson or his family member, Sandra Timpson. To give you context about the underlying matter, my understanding is that Mr. Timpson has intellectual disabilities and may have received care through DDSN or HHS, but we are unsure what OEPP agencies if any may have been involved.

Note that we have not yet identified any records in our office (ECOS) or in our Ombudsman's Office.
