The following sums were allotted from the Civil Contingent Fund:

J. S. Wilson, Supt. of the Penitentiary - \$150.00 for care of a prisoner who was injured in performing work assigned to him.

Mrs. John J. Drake - \$100.00 to cover expenses of attending a meeting of the Women's Council in New York.

Governor's Office - \$300.00 for office supplies.

Governor's Office - \$225.00 for special investigations.

The Commission instructed the Secretary to advise the Director of the Department of Public Welfare that it approved the use of Contingent appropriations carried in the 1944-45 General Appropriation Act for Board and Care of Children in emergency cases.
