"The SC DEW agrees that the passage of S. 1125 will effect the discontinuation of the payment of UI benefits to individuals separated for cause in cases that involve willful misconduct and/or negligence. SC DEW also agrees that the final two sentences of 41-35-12(2) allow SC DEW the discretion to award UI benefits to individuals separated for cause in cases involving extraordinary or emergency circumstances. Such circumstances may include, but are not limited to, personal or family medical or mortality issues."
