**Informational Report on Courses and Programs Offered Through the
Southern Regional Electronic Campus (SREC) 1999-2000**

The Southern Regional Education Board initiated the Southern Electronic Campus (SREC) in November 1997. The SREC is an electronic "marketplace" of programs, courses, and services that are available through technology. It allows students to take electronically delivered programs and courses offered by colleges and universities at times that are convenient for students.

Degree programs at the certificate/diploma, associates, upper-division baccalaureate, masters and doctoral levels are accepted by the SREC. Each college and university has pledged to follow the *Principles of Good Practice* developed by the SREC for all programs and courses offered in this electronic marketplace. Credits earned in programs and courses through the SREC may be transferable. The acceptance of credits and use of credits for program requirements are the decision of the college or university to which the credits are being transferred. Students should consult the college or university for transfer policies.

Participating institutions must name an institutional coordinator to coordinate the submission of program and course nominations, entering of courses and programs to the SREC web site, and response to any questions regarding its offerings.

A call for course and program nominations is issued each year for the Fall term. The institution and SREC are notified of the approval of nominations and the institution is instructed to enter the course/program to the SREC web site. Once all data is entered and approved by the SREB, the course/program is then activated in the Electronic Campus.

Programs and courses approved for the Fall term automatically roll over for the Spring and Summer terms. New courses and programs may be added at any time during the year by

following the required procedures. Consequently, the Electronic Campus changes daily. The most up-to-date offerings can be found on the SREC web site, www.srec.sreb.org.

Attached for your information is the most current listing of the approved courses and programs offered by South Carolina institutions for the 1999-2000 Academic Year. (Courses constituting degree programs are not shown unless they may be taken by students not enrolled in the degree program.)
