Description/Significant Features:

The sprawling single-story Colonial Revival residence is fourteen bays wide and clad in brick. A large pedimented portico, complete with dentils and supported by Doric columns, frames the building's central three bays which consists of an original paneled door (flanked by sidelights and topped by a broken pediment) flanked by arched window openings (with replacement windows) A cornice adorned with large decorative dentils runs below the roof line of the entire house and a large interior brick chimney stack rises from the building's western roof. The house displays both original six-over-six sash in addition to replacement one-over-one sash.
