


DETAILS OF CASEMENT WINDOWS No 1 & 2.



STUCCO PAINTED 3 COATS IVORY TO MATCH. ALL COLORS TO MATCH SAMPLES APPROVED BY PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT. ALL HARDWARE (LOUNGE, MEN'S TOILET, WOMEN'S TOILET) TO BE CHROMIUM SATIN FINISH. ELECTRIC P.B.
