SC Nursery and Landscape Association to Meet in Myrtle Beach

The South Carolina Nursery & Landscape Association will hold its annual trade show and seminar program on February 7-9, 2002 at the Myrtle Beach Convention Center in Myrtle Beach, SC.

Dr. Carl Whitcomb, Professor of Horticulture, teacher, researcher, and lecturer will give two presentations: Weed Control for Field Grown Trees and Propagation by Cuttings. He has written 4 books and won numerous awards dealing with horticulture. Dr. Don Ham, Dr. Ted Whitwell, Dr. Bill Bauerle, and Dr. Steve Jeffers, all from Clemson University will also speak. Judy Sharpton, Growing Places Inc. marketing specialist will give two presentations for retailers.

Other topics include Spanish Communication, Runoff Water Management, Risk Management, and water related topics will be discussed. Following the General Session, there are three concurrent educational sessions, one for landscapers, one for wholesale production, and one for retailers. More than 20 nursery and landscape related presentations will be given.

The Growing a Green Industry Business will be held on Friday February 9 for those who are interested in starting a greenhouse, nursery or landscape business. The program seminars include Taking Control of Your Business, Marketing 101, Get It in Writing - Legal Considerations for Your Business, and a panel discussion with industry members will be held. Registration for the program is \$75.00. Representatives from the various regulatory agencies will also be available for questions.

The seminar programs will be held on Thursday, February 7. The Trade show will be open Friday and Saturday, February 8-9. On site registration is \$55 per person for both the seminar program and the trade show, a trade show badge only is \$15. The 280 plus booth trade show offers a wide variety of plant material, equipment, and supplies for the nursery, greenhouse and landscape industry.

The Certified Nursery Professional test will be given on Saturday, February 9. Pre-registration is required for the test.

The South Carolina Greenhouse Growers Association will hold its Annual Winter Meeting in conjunction with this event. There will be a day full of seminars on Friday, February 8, with a 2 hour break to visit the trade show. The registration fee for the SCGGA winter meeting is \$30 and includes a badge for the trade show.

SC Pork Industry To Hold Conference

The conference will include a Board Meeting on Wednesday, a workshop on Artificial Insemination and a seminar on Economic Prospects of the U.S. Pork Industry on Thursday including an auction on Thursday evening and a conference wrap-up on Friday morning.

Forestry 101 Offered To Forest Landowners

The Lexington County Extension office invites landowners to participate in Forestry 101, a forestry course designed for beginners who wish to refresh their knowledge of forestry. The course will be held at the Lexington County Extension Office, 605 West Main St., Suite 109, (the old Kroger grocery store behind the Lizard's Thicket) in Lexington for six weeks beginning Thursday, February 7, 2002. Except for the final class, which is forest taxation, each class will be held from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.

Forestry 101 is the same course that college students would take as an elective course but with little or no homework and no "Tests."

Cost for the class is \$30. For those who wish to buy the college text, the cost is an additional \$50 for the textbook, Forest and Forestry, 5th Edition. The text is not mandatory, but is a great all-around reference book for forest landowners. Even though course participants may choose not to purchase the textbook, they will receive a course outline and helpful handouts.
