Quote from Haley press secretary Chaney Adams, "The governor is keeping all of those impacted in her prayers and asks everyone in South Carolina to do the same. She will continue to communicate with Jacob's family and the families of those two who were released throughout the weekend."

ON BACKGROUND: The governor rearranged her afternoon schedule to travel to the Upstate in the wake of the shooting. She visited with the family of Jacob - for an extended amount of time - on Wednesday night. She called Colin's mother after he'd been released from the hospital. And she called Ms. Hollingsworth who was injured. The governor provided all three families with her mobile phone number.
