For the current fiscal year, and for capital projects funded with revenues other than state funds, tuition, or academic fees, the project approval requirements of §59-103-35 and §2-47-40 are suspended for public institutions of higher education. Nothing in this provision should be construed as to exempt institutions of higher education from complying with any engineering standard or building code that would normally apply to such projects.
