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

Dear Senator McConnell:

The Senate Medical Affairs Committee has met on three occasions since the receipt of your letter referring Senator Sheheen's request for an investigation into the November 10th decision by the Department of Health and Environmental Control Board to approve a water quality certification for dredging operations along the Savannah River. We met on November 29th, December 2nd and December 8th. We heard testimony from six members of the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control Board, from six Department of Health and Environmental Control staff members and from four members of Governor Haley's staff. We requested that the chairman of the Savannah River Maritime Commission testify and upon advice of his attorney he declined.

Pursuant to your letter and Senator Sheheen's letter, by majority vote the Senate Medical Affairs Committee finds that there was no undue interference or no undue influence related to the Department of Health and Environmental Control Board's decision granting the 401 Water Quality Certification for the Savannah Harbor Expansion Project.
