Holly – Elizabeth McLean, Deputy Solicitor in Richland County (576-2078), has called our office asking if we plan to suspend Kelvin Washington.

There is gubernatorial precedent to suspend officers for tax related indictments as crimes of moral turpitude. Please see below.

- 1998-06 – Suspending York County Councilman upon indictment for three counts of willfully failing to make an income tax return to the IRS as a crime of moral turpitude.
- 1998-16 – Suspending Marion County Councilman for pleading guilty to two counts of failure to make income tax returns as a crime of moral turpitude.
- 1978-26 – Suspending McCormick County Supervisor upon indictment for charges of willfully filing false employer's quarterly tax returns with the IRS as a crime of moral turpitude.
