**MOX:**

Recall, DOE had two documents due for filing with the federal court on Monday – 1) an answer to our complaint, and 2) a response to our motion for summary judgment. DOE filed a request for an extension of time of 30 days on the response to our motion for summary judgment. DOE is also going to file a motion to dismiss our complaint on Monday. We have asked the court to decide both DOE’s motion to dismiss and our motion for summary judgment at the same time, rather than delaying our summary judgment motion to first decide the motion to dismiss. We will likely hear from the court on either Monday or Tuesday about the court’s timeline on these motions. We have heard nothing further on the Motion to Intervene.

**DV Task Force:**

Today, save-the-dates were emailed for the Governor’s Statewide DV Summit on Friday, May 20<sup>th</sup>. All members of the Task Force and certain local officials (solicitors, sheriffs, coroners, county council, etc.) are invited to attend. Recall that the purpose of the Summit will be to focus on county-led efforts against domestic violence.

Yesterday, Senate Finance fully funded the DV initiative for additional prosecutors to end officer prosecutions just as the House passed.
