

Grazing Management Clinic

The SC Grasslands Coalition is sponsoring a grazing management clinic at Clemson University's Simpson Station in Pendleton, SC, on October 17 and 18, 2000.

“The clinic is designed for the livestock producer who is just starting his operation as well as the manager who wants to increase his management efficiency," said Dr. James Riley Hill, chairman of the SC Grasslands Coalition. The clinic will feature expert instruction and hands-on exercises in soil testing and nutrient management, grazing system design and layout, grazing behavior, physiology of forage growth, and grazing methods.

The clinic will feature Jim Gerrish, principle agronomic researcher at the University of Missouri's Forage Systems Research Center in Linneus, MO. Gerrish's study focuses on plant/soil/animal relations in grazed pastures, and his research includes the impacts of grazing management systems on animal performance and economic return. He is also the co-founder of the popular 3-day grazing management workshop held at the University of Missouri, attended by over 2,200 producers and educators from 39 states and four Canadian provinces.

The clinic will begin on the morning of October 17th and end about mid-afternoon of October 18th. Cost of the two-day clinic is \$75 per person, which includes all educational materials as well as lunch, dinner and refreshments. Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis and will be limited to 40 participants. ServSafe Food Protection Manager Certification Course

Foodservice managers of school cafeterias, fast food service operations, restaurants, and other establishments are invited to participate in a food protection certification course on October 24-26, 2000, at the Ramada Inn in Clemson.

The course is designed to teach managers of food service operations the best methods and practices to protect food that they will learn in the ServSafe course. Managers are encouraged to return to their operations and teach their personnel those same food safety practices.

Sponsored by Clemson University Extension Service, the course offers information on food protection, sanitation, food flow through an operation, principles of a Hazardous Analysis Critical Control Point (HACCP) system, clean and sanitary facilities and equipment, and sanitation management. In addition, participants will receive a National Certification Exam and a Train-the-Trainer Workshop with employee training materials. Clemson University faculty certified as instructor trainers by the National Restaurant Association will teach the course with materials developed by the NRA. Guest speakers, lab activities, and field trips will be incorporated into the course.

Class size is limited to 35 participants. The registration fee of \$225 includes course book, training materials, thermometer, Leader's Guide for teaching the Employee's Course, breaks, and two lunches. Fall is here. The leaves are changing, and there's a crisp nip in the air. County fairs are in full swing. The State Fair is about to begin. Pumpkins are plentiful. Pork loins are on the grill. And, the pigskins are barreling through the goalposts---a sure sign that high school and college football games have begun. From pigskins to pork skins, the pork industry is a vital part of South Carolina's culture and agriculture.

Another sure sign of fall is National Pork Month. Since 1972, during the month of October producers have celebrated their wholesome, nutritious and versatile white meat alternative---pork. During the last 13 years producers have managed to reposition pork in the minds of consumers through their landmark checkoff-funded advertising campaign---"Pork. The Other White Meat@." Since that time, it has been a huge success.

Like football, farm prices for pork have bounced up and down. Yet, producers have held on to the thought that pork would, once again, rise above the crowd and bring them a greater profit margin. It has been a tough field on which to play, but they have held on to the ball through all of the blocks and tackles along the way. I commend each of our pork producers in South Carolina who generate approximately \$41 million in farm sales annually. In 1998, the last year of available information, nearly 1,100 producers marketed more than 270,000 hogs.

On the national level, pork is becoming a dominant player in the world of exports. The pork industry is positioning itself for this role in the coming decade by taking advantage of growing world population and economic growth of foreign markets. In less than 10 years the nation has become the second-largest pork exporter in the world. This trend of growth is expected to continue, in part, because of the efforts of checkoff-funded foreign market development efforts. Increased world population has created a demand for pork representing 41% of the world meat consumption. South Carolina pork producers are gearing up for this market.

In addition to exporting pork products, many countries buy their breeding stock from our hog breeders. Several years ago, farmers from Costa Rica came to South Carolina solely to buy breeding stock. There is a demand for everything but the "oink" worldwide.

The number of hog farms in South Carolina has plummeted in the past few years due, in part, to a new state law restricting livestock operations almost to the point of not operating at all. Because of the law, South Carolina has some of the most stringent rules and regulations in the nation governing livestock operations. The truth is that South Carolina producers are deeply committed to protecting the environment. They care about clean air, clean water, and land conservation. Two programs have been established in recent years using checkoff dollars to provide comprehensive information, training, and scientific research to assist producers in maintaining environmentally sustainable and economically viable operations. The On-Farm Odor/Environmental Assistance Program (OFO/EAP) is a key strategic plan for the overall environmental strategy of pork producers. The focus of the plan is to protect air and water quality while maintaining and improving the efficiency of production for all sizes and types of operations.

Free on-farm assessments are funded through America's Clean Water Foundation, a recipient of a \$5 million grant from the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). OFO/EAP assessments have been available to pork producers across the state. Environmental management at hog operations focuses on two key factors---reducing odor and preventing contamination of surface and groundwater. The goal of OFO/EAP is to provide pork producers with a comprehensive assessment of both odor and water quality risk factors in their operations.

I commend our pork producers and others in the industry as well as the South Carolina Pork Board for the goals they have set. While the demand for pork steadily increases, our producers remain deeply concerned about maintaining a quality environment. They care about America. They care about South Carolina.

In this fall football season of excitement in South Carolina, pork would make a great selection for any Tailgating Party---A Great Pigskin combination. So, whether you're a football fan looking for a tailgating idea or the family chef preparing a meal at home, look for alternative meat dishes to enjoy this fall and celebrate October with ---"Pork. The Other White Meat.
