BACKGROUND:

Propulsion SC is a very exciting for Boeing SC because it represents the first big piece of production that goes directly to another airplane program, rather than our Engineering Center of Design, IT Center of Excellence, and Boeing Research and Technology which are business units that support the entire enterprise. Propulsion SC will build the engine inlets (the front part of the engine) for the new 737MAX (and current 737s) and the 777x airplanes.

Propulsion represents a significant vertical integration bringing this manufacturing back internal to Boeing and job creation in SC as opposed to outsourcing to our suppliers which we have done in the past.

The ribbon cutting event will be 10-11am on Feb. 11. It will be at the new facility located on Patriot Boulevard, next to Interiors Responsibility SC about 10 miles north of the main site. Ray Conner, Vice Chairman of Boeing and President & CEO of Boeing Commercial Airplanes, will attend and speak at the event. Tim Keating and Judge Luttig will both be down for the event.
