WHEREAS, staying focused on the road and alert for potential dangers, including disabled vehicles, spilled cargo, adverse weather conditions, and unpredictable driver behaviors, enables motorists to react quickly and safely in most situations; and

WHEREAS, practicing safe habits, eliminating distractions, maintaining safe speeds, and driving defensively are of vital importance in avoiding preventable crashes; and

WHEREAS, the Sunday after Thanksgiving is traditionally the busiest highway travel day of the year.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim November 30, 2014, as

DRIVE SAFER SUNDAY

throughout the state and encourage all South Carolinians to practice safe driving habits and to work together to ensure the safety of all highway users this holiday season and every time they get behind the wheel.
