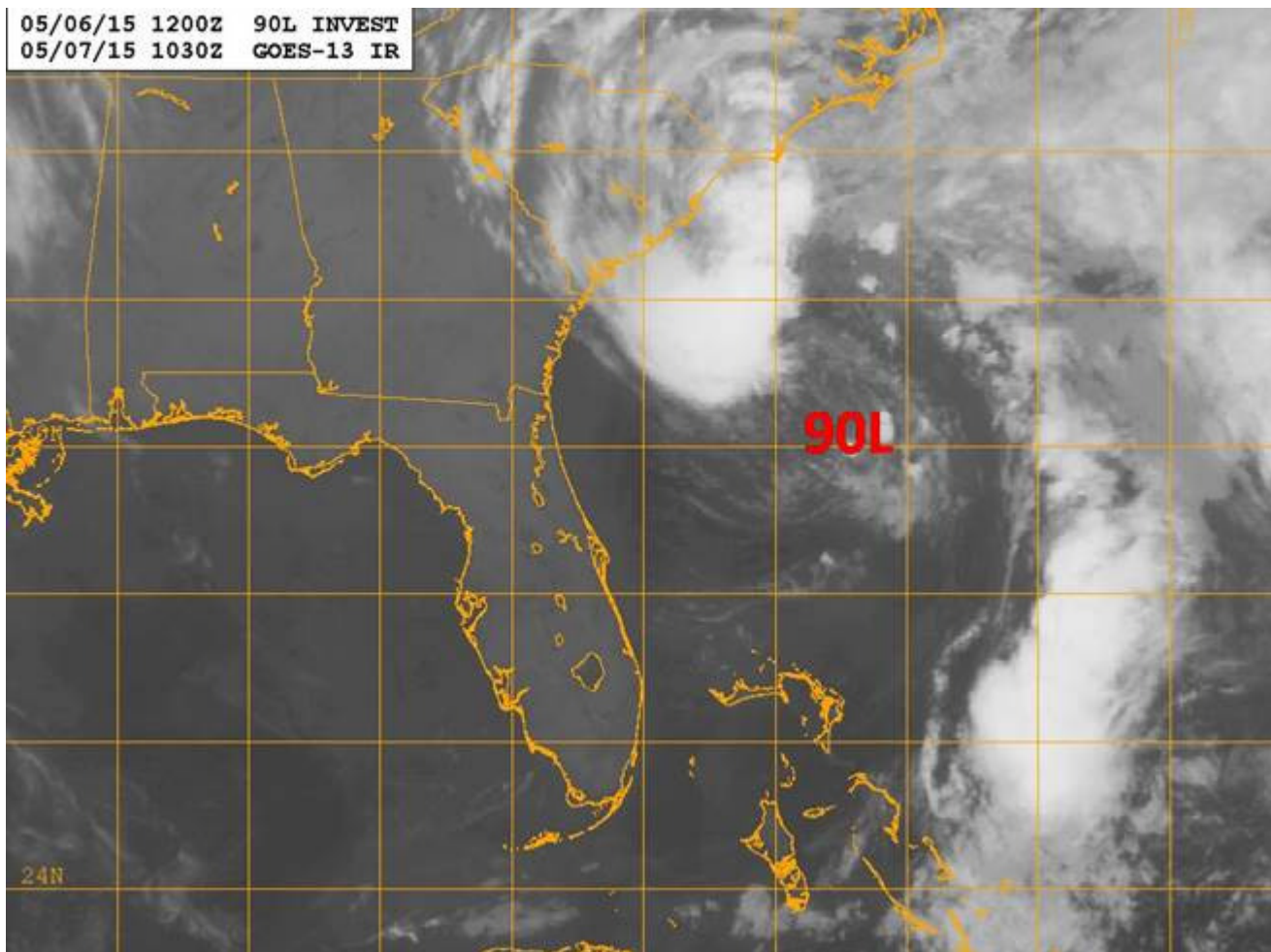

Today's Update:

The NHC has again increased the chance that the system will become a sub-tropical or tropical feature to **70%** in the next 48 hours. Forecasts call for the storm to remain offshore and hit the coast with strong surf and rip currents and 24-40 mph winds on Friday and Saturday. The system should move past our state entirely on Sunday.

Update on the Tropical System:

The National Hurricane Center is giving this offshore low pressure system a 60% chance of sub-tropical or tropical development in the next 2-5 days. Forecasts show that it will most likely be a rain event for South Carolina. Maximum winds of 35 -40 mph remain offshore along with the heavy rain.
