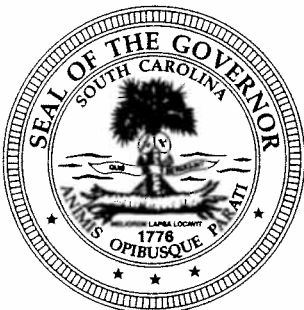
WHEREAS, a well-educated work force, with academic and work experience, contributes to a more productive society; and
