Also my wife's medical records, home deed & any other papers returned to our household since we are aged we will hire someone - preferably Winnie Smalls if she is available to manage the household & she is also a CNA. If the Court so desires they can make a weekly inpropta inspection as to our living conditions for a reasonable period - one month should be satisfactory. The kids may call their mother but not be too intrusive. They can also visit under supervision until and if the situation improves. We do not know how much time we have left to live so we think this is the most logical end. For we will not make any further concessions or commitments at this time.
