Center for Fathers and Families Relationship with the General Assembly/State Government:

- DSS has 2 contracts with the Center for Fathers and Families.
 1. Provides a comprehensive Fatherhood Initiative to Support Fathers and Families.
 - Activities to promote responsible parenting through activities such as counseling, mentoring, and mediation, disseminating information about good parenting practices, skilled-based parenting education, encouraging child support payments, and other methods.
 - Activities to foster economic stability by helping fathers improve their economic status by providing activities such as work first services, job search , job training, subsidized employment, job retention, job enhancement, and encouraging education, including career-advancing education, dissemination of employment materials, coordination with existing employment services such as welfare-to-work programs, referrals to local employment training initiatives, and other methods.
 2. Provides meeting space for Strategy Team Meetings, staff support for meetings, third party evaluation for pilot and planning process, assist in identifying the researcher and facilitator, and providing expertise and knowledge of working with hard-to-employ non-custodial parents.
