COLUMBIA, S. C., January 3, 1945.

The Budget Commission met in the Governor's Office at 11:00 o'clock on January 3, 1945. All members of the Commission were present. This was the first meeting of the Commission under the administration of Governor Ransome J. Williams, successor to United States Senator Olin D. Johnston.

The following appropriation transfer was approved by the Commission:

Superintendent of Education

Item 2. Superintendence and Records
From Travel - Accounts \$1.56 - To Item 1. Board of
Education - B-2 Travel.

The Commission allotted from the Civil Contingent Fund to the Governor's Office, \$500.00 for Special Investigations, and \$500.00 for Office Equipment.

Dr. James H. Hope and Mr. E. W. Rushton appeared before the Commission and requested an allotment of \$2,000.00 for use in connection with the adoption of the Twelve Grade Program. The Commission declined to make this allotment, and suggested that the matter be presented to the General Assembly.

Mr. H. M. McElveen appeared before the Commission and requested \$1,000.00 from the Civil Contingent Fund for exercising equipment at the Crippled Children's Home at Florence. The Commission declined to make this allotment, and advised that the matter be presented to the General Assembly.

The Commission then adjourned.
