.....**Recommendation:** The staff suggests that the Committee on Academic Affairs and Licensing recommend to the Commission that it grant to The Charleston School of Law approval to advertise and enroll students for classes to begin in September 2004, provided that 1) no "unique cost" or other special state funding be required or requested; 2) that CSOL submit to the Commission updated material to document compliance with the licensing requirements and the recommendations of the team as enumerated in the Team Report and shown below; 3) that a team visit the Charleston facility in May 2004 to confirm compliance; 4) that the team and the staff provide updated reporting and final recommendations to the Committee and the Commission in summer 2004; 5) that the institution establish a timeline under which it will gain ABA accreditation; report to the CHE staff on each step in the timeline; provide to the CHE staff a copy of correspondence to and from ABA, and discontinue advertising and enrolling students into the program if it becomes apparent that it is unable to meet its timeline to gain ABA accreditation; and **6) in the event that the school, or its officers or agents, should make an attempt to cause the school to become a part of the College of Charleston or any other public institution, the license granted to the school shall be null and void and immediately revoked.**
