As a result of hazardous weather conditions related to severe thunderstorms, flash flood warnings, high wind warnings, tornado watches, and tornado warnings, Governor McMaster has issued Executive Order 2017-06 which is attached. Also attached is a list of the early dismissals by date and county. In accordance with S.C. Code of Laws Section 8-11-57, the Governor has granted leave with pay for state employees as outlined in his order. Essential non-exempt employees who were required to work during this time should earn compensatory time on an hour for hour basis for the hours worked.
