The Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) announced that "nationwide, 77.8 million consumers saved \$3.4 billion up front on their premiums as insurance companies operated more efficiently. The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) posted online the Guidance on State Alternative Applications for Health Coverage. The guidance outlines how State-based Marketplaces (SBMs), as well as Medicaid and CHIP agencies, may choose to use the model single, streamlined application developed by HHS, or may develop an alternative single, streamlined application that is approved by CMS.
