As our office continues to track the pipeline issue, we appreciate receiving feedback from industry folks on their needs as you hear these requests. Just in case any of your members are not aware: At this time, the Hours of Service waiver is still in effect from Hurricane Matthew through midnight on Thursday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>. The weight limit restrictions are waived through February 1<sup>st</sup>. Because our State of Emergency from the recent Hurricane ends tomorrow, we are already looking at extending the hours of service waiver based on the hurricane issues that still exist. I will keep you posted.
