Syria - 2 refugees  
Ukraine - 5 refugees

According to our records and cross-referenced against records and information obtained from the federal government, two individuals of Syrian national origin have been resettled in South Carolina in the last 5+ years. In this fiscal year, through February 29th, 84 refugees were resettled in the state and two of those 84 refugees were of Syrian national origin. The 84 refugees that were resettled in this fiscal year through February 29th came from approximately 8 different countries.
