### Notice to tobacco farmers

This month, eligible tobacco farmers should receive their share of the state's tobacco settlement for 1999. Sixty-three percent of all tobacco growers should receive checks by the end of the month, and 51 percent of quota-owners should receive checks, said Les Tindal, Commissioner of Agriculture.

If you are a tobacco grower or quota-owner and you do not receive an expected check, it is likely that you either didn't turn in the necessary certification forms or did not fully complete your forms. It is very important for you to receive your share of the tobacco companies' pay-out, so if you are having trouble completing your forms, contact your local Farm Service Agency office for help. If you do not receive a check this month, you can still complete the appropriate forms by March 15 and receive your 1999 pay-out in April 2000—provided you accurately complete and return your forms.

More than 6,800 eligible tobacco farmers and quota holders either didn't return their settlement forms or did not fully complete their forms, which were mailed to growers and quota holders. If you are a tobacco grower or quota holder and never received your forms, contact your local FSA office. Or, if you received your forms, but another farmer you know did not, please assist your fellow grower or quota-owner in getting his/her forms.

### Angus-Brangus sale and farm show

The 3rd annual Mid-Carolina Angus-Brangus Alliance Bull and Heifer Sale will be held in conjunction with a farm show at the Sumter County Exhibition Center.

In an effort to interest more farmers in raising feeder calves, the Angus Brangus-Alliance will couple a farm show with its annual sale, which should bring farmers of all types to Sumter's Exhibition Center, located on West Liberty Street.

The Farm Show will begin at 8:30 a.m. on Jan. 29 at the Center, and the sale will begin at 1 p.m. at the Sumter County Fairgrounds, located behind the Center. More than 20 large farm equipment dealers and industry exhibitors have committed to the event. They will display farm tractors, tillage equipment; fencing; cattle handling equipment; feed, mineral and health supplies; seed dealers; hay equipment; and educational and financial services.

Twenty Angus or Brangus bulls and 30 commercial heifers will be available at the sale.

## Commissioner's Column

### Mapping for the future

Since it's the season of giving, I guess I shouldn't have been surprised. But because many companies are usually looking for big profits during this time of year, I was a little taken aback when I found out a local insurance agent would begin giving a free service to farmers.

And it's costing him thousands of dollars.

Naturally, there are strings attached. But not many.

I'm talking about Ray Fleming of the Midlands Agency, an insurance company here in Columbia. Last month he held a demonstration to show farmers how he planned to help them—by using a satellite-controlled mapping system to draw complete, accurate maps of their farms, including designations of each individual crop field. Of course, only Fleming's clients can receive the service, but to them, it will come in handy to say the least.

If you aren't a farmer or have never had crop insurance, you may not realize just how useful these maps will be. Whenever a farmer takes out crop insurance, he must submit the number of acres he has planted of each crop, and it's no easy task to compute that acreage,

especially if the farm is spread across many fields. The costs of the insurance premiums are based on that acreage. So if a farmer estimates he has about 100 acres of cotton planted and actually has only 91.5 acres in cotton, he's paying too much for his insurance.

The satellite mapping system Ray is providing will eliminate that guesswork—and therefore

save money for many farmers. And there is an obvious advantage for the insurance agent who uses that farmer's map—he or she won't be paying a claim for 100 acres of cotton when there are only 91.5.

Ray uses a Global Positioning System to map the fields. A GPS receiver is mounted on an ATV, and the receiver is connected to a computer nestled between the vehicle's handlebars. To measure and map a farm, Fleming or one of his agents drives the ATV around the perimeter of each field. As the ATV is driven across the field, the GPS unit signals orbiting satellites every two seconds to pinpoint its location. As the signals are received, the computer "connects the dots," drawing the field perimeter on the screen. The receiver must connect with at least four satellites to accurately map the field, and it can connect to as many as 12 satellites. The more satellites with which the receiver connects, the more accurate the map will be. What's even more impressive is you can eliminate unused farmland that might lie within the field's perimeter from the total acreage that is calculated. For instance, if you have a small pond or patch of trees in the midst of your cornfield, that area will not be added to your total crop acreage.

Once the ATV operator has finished tracing the perimeters of the farm, the small computer that rests between the handlebars is taken to Ray's Midland Agency office and connected to their office computer. The larger computer uses the information to map the entire farm, color codes each separate field and the lists exact acreage, to a hundredth of an acre.

This technology has been around for some time, but the cost has prohibited many farmers from taking advantage of it. I only hope that more of our farmers will one day have access not only to this technology, but also to the technology of precision farming. With precision farming, fields are also mapped as I described above. In addition, soil samples are analyzed and stored in computers in tractors. Then, as farmers are tilling the soil, the correct amount of nitrogen and other soil nutrients are added automatically. This way, farmers never use too much or too little of a nutrient or chemical.

Few farmers can afford this expensive equipment, but hopefully it
