> on December 22nd. I was told that Wyndhams response was I quit, and
> to send in a my termination letter, which I promptly did. 55 days
> after I applied, my response was I was denied. Based on the fact they
> looked at the termination letter, instead of what Wyndhams response
> was that I quit. I was not told that I needed to defend what was in the
> termination letter. Wyndham is saying I was never on approved for
> FMLA, & I quit. I have all the proof. of doctors notes and proof that I
> was on FMLA. I feel I was unjustly denied due to their employees
> errors. I am being told I need to appeal. However I cannot wait
> another month without a check. by that time I will be evicted.
> I have contacted Cherly Stanton's office. I was told that"
> "I quit" does not mean I quit. And I did not show that I was
> terminated, and why I missed the days I was out.
> I have all recording of conversations, and copies of emails. So when
> I am evicted, and have to leave all my possessions I've worked so hard
> for all my life, because I don't have money for a move or somewhere
> to move to.
> Due to my medical bills and being out on FMLA, my saving are gone. I
> have not turned on my heat this week, knowing my electric will be cut
> off this weekend.
> I should not have to wait on and appeal. The employees are in the
> wrong.
