WHEREAS, young people develop crucial decision-making skills during early adolescence which shape their future values and attitudes; and

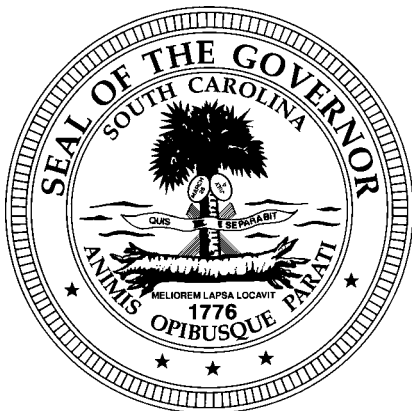
